Ornament Table Runner

Supply List

Required Feet & Machine Items

- Embroidery Foot #26
- Patchwork Foot #97/#97D or preferred 1/4-inch foot
- BERNINA Stitch Regulator (BSR)
- Walking Foot #50 for straight quilting
- BERNINA Lap-seam Foot #71 for binding
- Embroidery machine with embroidery module
- BERNINA Large Oval Hoop (or larger compatible hoop, if available)

Needles, Thread & Bobbins

- Embroidery needle size 75/11 or 80/12
- If using the class sample, bring Isacord: 0670 cream, 5510 emerald, 0704 gold, 1902 red, 5555 holly green, 5230 leaf veins, 5324 evergreen needles, 0932 branch brown, 1900 berry red, and 0015 white
- Coordinating SERALENE bobbin thread; bring extra bobbins
- Piecing, quilting, and binding thread

Embroidery & Appliqué Supplies

- Two layers of OESD Ultra Clean & Tear stabilizer for each hooping
- Three full-size placement templates supplied by the instructor
- Removable fabric-marking pen or pencil
- Small sharp appliqué scissors
- Pressing cloth
- Iron and pressing surface

Fabric & Pre-Class Cutting

- Cream center: cut 1 piece 19 1/2" x 11 1/2"
- Gold frame: cut 2 strips 1" x 11 1/2" and 2 strips 1" x 20 1/2"
- Assorted red, green, white/cream, and holly fabrics: cut 12 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- Assorted red, green, white/cream, and holly fabrics: cut 6 strips 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"
- Binding: cut 3 strips 2" x width of fabric for attachment with BERNINA Lap-seam Foot #71
- Backing: cut 1 piece 16" x 36"
- OESD Fuse and Fleece: bring 15" wide x approximately 36" long; do not trim to final size before class
- Appliqué fabrics: bring generous scraps of green, cream/ivory, and red; do not pre-cut the ornament shapes

Fabric Amounts to Bring

Gold 1/4 yard • Red 1 fat quarter • Green 1 fat quarter • White/Cream 1 fat quarter • Holly print 1 fat quarter • Binding 1/4 yard • Backing 1/2 yard

Optional Embroidery Design Choice

Students may use their own embroidery design if desired. Bring every thread color, stabilizer, appliqué fabric, and specialty supply required for that design. The alternate design must fit the available embroidery field and hoop.
