Introduction to English Paper Piecing Student Supply List

Fabric:

• Assorted scraps for hexagon and diamond pieces (at least 4" square); no need to cut into squares. You'll need fabric for seven hexagon shapes and six diamond shapes. Mini charm packs work nicely for the hexagon shapes.

Scissors:

- Fabric shears
- Small, sharp scissors for snipping thread
- Paper scissors

Notions:

- Hand sewing thread in a neutral color to match your fabric (Any weight or fiber content is fine you will be using this for basting only.)
- Your favorite thimble
- Seam ripper (just in case!)
- Small ruler (a 1" x 6" acrylic ruler is ideal)
- Fabric pen/pencil
- Needle threader (optional)

Miscellaneous:

- Paper punch
- Reading glasses, if necessary :)
- Washable glue stick or fabric glue pen (optional)

You will be provided with a kit containing the following items on the day of class.

- 6 diamond paper shapes
- 7 hexagon paper shapes
- 2 Wonder Clips
- 1 straw/milliner needle, size 9
- 1 straw/milliner needle, size 11
- a bobbin of The Bottom Line thread
