

## **Zip Pouch 101 Supply List**

### **Fabric and Notions:**

- Patchwork squares for outside of pouch: 42 - 2" squares of quilting cotton
- Lining fabric: one fat quarter or two 6" x 12" rectangles of quilting cotton
- Lightweight fusible interfacing: ½ yd., or two 6" x 14" pieces
- Nylon or polyester zipper at least 12" long
- Fabric for zipper tabs: strip of quilting cotton 1-1/2" x 4"
- Low-loft cotton batting: two 6" x 12" rectangles

### **Basic Sewing Kit:**

- Machine piecing thread in a neutral shade to match your fabrics. (I like Aurifil 50 wt and used shade 2021 for my sample.)
- Fabric shears (a pair with thin blades is helpful)
- Thread snips or scissors
- Straight pins
- Hand sewing needle and thimble

### **Sewing Machine, etc.:**

- Sewing machine in working order
- 90/14 Microtex or Topstitch sewing machine needle
- ¼" patchwork foot
- Walking foot
- Zipper foot
- Zig zag or overcast foot

### **Rotary Cutting Supplies:**

- Rotary cutter with a fresh blade
- Acrylic ruler (4" x 14" is a good size)
- Rotary cutting mat (12" x 18" is sufficient)

### **Pressing Supplies:**

- Small pressing board and iron, if you have
- Pressing cloth
- Spray bottle with water

### **Additional Supplies:**

- Tailor's awl
- Clover Wonder Clips

I would encourage you to cut your fabric prior to class, especially the 2" squares for the outside of the pouch, so that you have plenty of time in class to complete your project.

**Note:** If you would like to make a pouch similar to my sample, I will have precut kits available to purchase for \$5.00 each. The kit contains 42 - 2" squares of solid fabric for the outside of the pouch and a 1-1/2" x 4" strip for your zipper tabs. It does not contain the lining fabric, interfacing, batting, or zipper.
