

## Rapid Fire Hunter's Star Supply List and Cutting Instructions

Sewing machine in good working order
Rotary Cutter with new blade inserted/cutting mat 3"x18" ruler
Scissors
Thread, Fine pins, seam ripper
New sewing machine needle (70/10)
Rapid Fire Hunter Star Ruler with pattern (available for purchased at the OCS - Large Hunter Star Ruler or Petite Hunter Star Ruler) Invisigrip for back of ruler (optional) (available for sale at the OCS)

FABRIC - use non directional fabric, no stripes or plaids RECOMMEND USING HIGH CONTRAST FABRICS FOR STARS TO GET BETTER CONTRAST.


## Precutting Directions

You can choose to use either the Large Rapid Fire Hunter's Star or the Petite Rapid Fire Hunter's Star (Difference between the Large and Petite Hunter Star is the size of the Star.)

Cutting directions for:
The Large Rapid Fire Hunter 's Star - makes 7", 8", 9" and 10" blocks: We will be making the 8" block, Two Color Quilt Project, 36" x 36 " before borders.

1 Yard - from the Dark Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips $8 " x$ the WOF (width of fabric). Cut into 8 squares $8 " \times 8$ ". Then cut into 16 half Square triangles
- Cut 3 strips 2 1/4" x WOF
- Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for star points

1 Yard - from Light Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips 8" x the WOF (width of fabric). Cut into 8 squares 8 " x 8 ". Then cut into 16 half square triangles
- Cut 3 strips 2 1/4" x WOF
- Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for star points


## Extra fabric will be needed for border

## OR

Cutting Directions for:
The Petite Rapid Fire Hunter's Star - makes 5 ", 6 ", 7 " and 8 " blocks: We will be making the 6" block, Two Color Quilt Project 24 " x 24 " wall hanging (without border) or table runner.

3/4 Yard from Dark Fabrics: PRECUT

1. Cut 2 strips 6 " $\times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares 6 " $\times 6$ ". Then cut into 16 half square triangles
2. Cut 2 strips $13 / 4$ " x WOF
3. Cut 3 strips 2 1/4" x WOF

3/4 Yard from Light Fabrics: PRECUT

1. Cut 2 strips $6 " \times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares $6 " \times 6$ ". Then cut into 16 half square triangles
2. Cut 2 strips $13 / 4$ " x WOF
3. Cut 3 strips $21 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF

## Extra fabric will be needed for borders.

If your would like to use 3 different colors (that will make all the stars the same color) or 4 different colors please email me and I will send you those fabric requirements and cutting instructions. Also if you would rather make a larger quilt than a wall hanging or table runner call me or email me and let me know how many colors you would like to use and I will give you fabric requirements and cutting directions.
