

ByAnnie Ultimate Travel Bag Workshop Student Supply List

Depending on how far you are along on your bag, you may or may not need all the supplies listed below.

Pattern: Ultimate Travel Bag or Ultimate Travel Bag 2.0

Fabric and Notions: see pattern for full list of supplies needed.

- Note – avoid directional prints for best results
- You may wish to buy extra fabric just to be safe.
- ByAnnie sells finishing kits; see the ByAnnie.com website for more details.

Basic Sewing Kit

- Thread in neutral shade to match fabric; I recommend So Fine by Superior Threads because it's fine enough for machine quilting but strong too.
- Pins:
 - Flat Flowerhead pins for pinning stabilizer and zippers
 - Quilter's extra-fine pins for pinning fabric
- Fabric shears
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Hand sewing needle
- Thimble, if you like

Sewing Machine, etc.

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot with guide bar
- 1/4" patchwork foot
- Zipper foot (if you don't have a 1/4" patchwork foot and/or are not using handbag zippers)
- Zig zag stitch foot
- 90/14 Microtex or Topstitch needle

Rotary Cutting Supplies

- Rotary cutter, 45 mm or larger
- Acrylic rulers - my favorite sizes:
 - 4" x 14"
 - 6" x 24"
- Cutting mat, 18" x 24"

Miscellaneous Tools & Notions

- Clover Wonder Clips, package of 50
- Clover Chaco Liner (white only) or Frixion pen

- Hera marker
- Clover Tailor's Awl or stiletto
- Wooden finger press
- Bodkin or large safety pin
- Roxanne Glue-Baste-it
- 1/4" double-sided basting tape
- Fray Check

Optional Supplies

- Machine quilting gloves
- Turn It All Tube Turner
- ½" bias tape maker
- Glue stick
- Painter's tape
