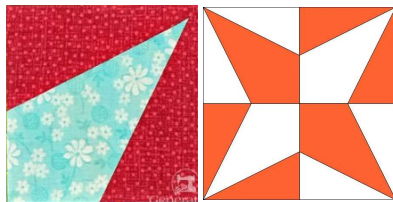




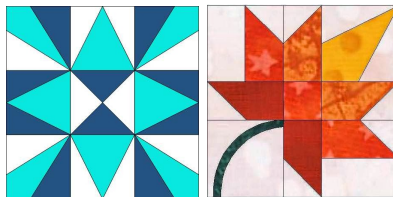

## **1-501 Corner Beam & Sliver -**



Quilters will be preserving those crisp clean lines and points by oversizing the components of the Corner Beam. Trimming the unit to the final size with the guidelines provided on the tool ensures precision when combining these units with others. This one tool provides eleven different sizes for trimming.



The Corner Beam will add many unique options to your quilt designs. The combinations of twists and turns makes it look as if you had to work with lots of odd shaped pieces when in fact you didn't. The construction of a Sliver unit advances the use of the Corner Beam and once again makes precise piecing look so difficult!

**\*Required tools:** Corner Beam which can be purchased at the Old Country Store

### **Basic Sewing Supplies -**

- Sewing Machine with a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
  - Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
  - Snips or trimming scissors
  - Seam ripper
  - Extra fine Pins
- A list of your Studio 180 (Deb Tucker) tools

### **Basic Quilting Supplies:**

- Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixon pen or mechanical pencil)
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler 6"x12" or so
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for the back of wing clipper
- Quilter's Magic Wand or other 1/4" seam guide

**Fabric Requirements:** For course 1-501, we recommend the following yardage: these are approximations or you can use your left over fabric from the last classes.

1/4 yard Focal Fabric

1/4 yard Background (light)

1/4 yard of a coordinating or contrasting fabric with the focal fabric

**CUTTING CHARTS for 4" Finished Units** Look at the samples of the corner beam units to get ideas for fabric placement. I will use Fabric A to denote center and Fabric B for side triangles.



**Fabric A** - cut 4 - 5" squares for center

**Fabric B** - 5" WOF



When choosing fabrics for this unit called Sliver you will start with 2 squares - one will make the large triangle section of your sliver unit and the other square will be the middle sliver section of your unit.

**Fabric A** - Middle sliver section cut 4 - 5 1/2" squares

**Fabric B** - Large outside triangle cut 4 - 5 1/2" squares

**Fabric C** - Small outside triangle - 5" strip WOF (can be the same as fabric B or contrasting fabric)

Separate each unit's fabric into a ziplock bag and label.
