**1-801 Rapid Lemoyne Star Advanced 2 - Banded Lemoyne and Fussy Cut Lemoyne Star** Ever wonder how to use the wider end of your Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool? The secret is now revealed of course! Impress your toughest critic with what looks like very demanding piecing, but trick them with the simplicity of Banded Lemoyne Star and the Fussy Cut Lemoyne Star.

**Prerequisite: Knowledge of the basic Lemoyne Star construction.** To help ensure your success in this course, it will be important for you to be familiar with the basic construction of the Rapid Lemoyne Star. If you have not made a Lemoyne Star using the Rapid Fire tool in a while, you may want to practice your skills prior to class. You can review the technique on [studio180design.net](http://studio180design.net) under the ribbon for videos and type in Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star.

**\*Required tools:** Lemoyne Star Tool which can be purchased at the Old Country Store

#### **Basic Sewing Supplies -**

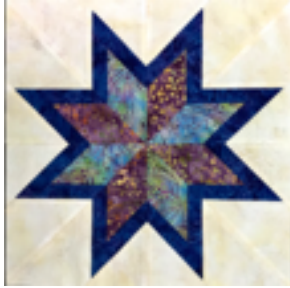
- Sewing Machine with a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
- Snips or trimming scissors
- Seam ripper
- Extra fine Pins
- Pressing stick (if you have one)
- Clapper (if you have one)

#### **Basic Quilting Supplies:**

- Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixion pen or mechanical pencil)
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler 6"x12"
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for the back of tool
- Tucker Trimmer 3 or 12 1/2" square ruler for squaring up blocks

**Fabric Requirements and Precutting Directions:** In this class you will make 2 - 8" blocks. It is strongly suggested for you to pre-cut your fabrics prior to class. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** When selecting fabric there should be a strong contrast between your star point fabrics and your background fabric.

## Precutting Directions for class



**Banded Lemoyne Star** - Your **diamond strips** can be from the same fabric or 2 different fabrics. For your **banding strip** it should be from the same fabric and one that contrasts nicely with the background fabric and the star point fabric.

Fabric #A Diamond (1 strip) - 1 3/4" x 1/2 WOF

Fabric #B Diamond (1 strip) - 1 3/4" x 1/2 WOF

Fabric #C Banding strip (4 strips) - 1 1/4" x 1/2 WOF

Background (8) - 3 3/4" squares



### **Fussy Cut Lemoyne Star -**

Fabric A - Diamond Strip - **works best with large print fabric or striped fabric.** 1/4 yard (this is more than enough since we only need 8 - 2 1/2" diamonds but will give you enough fabric to play with) We will cut the fabric in class.

Background (8) - 3 3/4" squares
