1-901 Rapid Lemoyne Star Advanced 3 - Lemoynes as Triangles and Blazing Lemoyne Star And the fun continues. What else can we do with our Lemoyne Star tool. Why not try Lemoynes as Triangles for a great border or a Blazing Lemoyne Star for the center of your quilt. **Prerequisite: Knowledge of the basic Lemoyne Star construction.** To help ensure your success in this course, it will be important for you to be familiar with the basic construction of the Rapid Lemoyne Star. If you have not made a Lemoyne Star using the Rapid Fire tool in a while, you may want to practice your skills prior to class. You can review the technique on studio180design.net under the ribbon for videos and type in Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star.

***Required tools:** Lemoyne Star Tool which can be purchased at the Old Country Store

Basic Sewing Supplies -

- Sewing Machine with a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
- Snips or trimming scissors
- Seam ripper
- Extra fine Pins
- Pressing stick (if you have one)
- Clapper (if you have one)

Basic Quilting Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixon pen or mechanical pencil)
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler 6"x12"
- Invisigrip for the back of tool
- Tucker Trimmer 3 or 12 1/2" square ruler for squaring up blocks

Fabric Requirements and Precutting Directions: In this class you will make 1 - 18" Blazing Lemoyne block and 2 Lemoynes as Triangle blocks. It is strongly suggested for you to pre-cut your fabrics prior to class. **IMPORTANT NOTE: When selecting fabric there should be a strong contrast between your star point fabrics and your background fabric.**

Precutting Directions for class



Lemoynes as Triangles Your **diamond strips** can be from the same fabric or 2 different fabrics.

Fabric #A Diamond (1 strip) - 2 1/2" x 1/2 WOF

Fabric #B Diamond (1 strip) - 2 1/2" x 1/2 WOF

Background (2 strips) - 3 3/4" x 1/2 WOF



Blazing Lemoyne Star -

Fabric A - Inner Diamond Strip (red) - 1 strip 2 1/2" x **WOF**

Fabric B - Middle Diamond Strip (green) - 2 strips 2 1/2" x **WOF**

Fabric C - Outer Diamond Strip (burgundy) - 1 strip 2 1/2" x **WOF**

Large Background Squares (4) - 6 1/2" squares (Cut on the diagonal into equal half square triangles)

Small Background Squares (4) - 5" squares (Cut on the diagonal into equal half square triangles)

WOF = Width of Fabric
