1-1001 Large Square Squared - More squares inside of squares inside of squares. The Large Square Squared is a perfect format to feature any fussy cuts or embroidery pieces. But it doesn't stop there! Have you ever seen a quilt with a snail's trail block and thought it was too difficult than you will fall in love with the Large Square Squared which simplifies this complex block.

Basic Sewing Supplies -

- -Sewing Machine with a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- -Thread 50 wt is good for piecing
- -Snips or trimming scissors
- -Seam ripper
- -Extra fine Pins

Basic Quilting Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking pen or pencil (frixon pen or mechanical pencil)
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler 6"x12"
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for the back of tool

Fabric Requirements and Precutting Directions: In this class you will make a 12" economy block and a 12" Snails trail block

Precutting Directions for class



For the **12 1/2**" *Economy Block* - Each set of squares should be from a different fabric.

- 1 3 1/2" Square for the center
- 2 3 1/2" Squares for the first round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles
- 2 4 1/4" Squares for the second round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles
- 2 5 1/2" Squares for the third round: sub cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles
- 2 7 1/4" Squares for the forth round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles

For the **12 1/2**" *Snail's Trail* block you will need to cut the following: (you can choose a different fabric for each round if you want or use the same fabric for each round)



- 1 3 1/2" Square for first round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
- 1 4 1/4" Square for second round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
- 1 5 1/2" Square for third round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
- 1 7 1/4" Square for forth round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles

From **Background fabric** cut:

- 1 3 1/2" Square for the center
- 1 3 1/2" Square for first round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
- 1 4 1/4" Square for second round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
- 1 5 1/2" Square for third round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
- 1 7 1/4" Square for forth round; sub cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles
