BABY SIZE	38" x 47.5"	17 fat eighths 8 fat quarters 9 1/4 yards 25 2.5" x WOF strips	Binding - 3/8 yard Backing - 2 5/8 yards Batting - 44" x 53"
SMALL THROW	47.5" x 57"	25 fat eighths 11 fat quarters 13 1/4 yards 38 2.5" x WOF strips	Binding - 1/2 yard Backing - 3 1/8 yards Batting - 53" x 63"
THROW	57" x 66.5"	35 fat eighths 15 fat quarters 18 1/4 yards 53 2.5" x WOF strips	Binding - 1/2 yard Backing - 3 5/8 yards Batting - 63" x 72"
LARGE THROW	66.5" x 76"	47 fat eighths 20 fat quarters 24 1/4 yards 70 2.5" x WOF strips	Binding - 5/8 yards Backing - 4 1/4 yards Batting - 72" x 82"
TWIN SIZE	66.5" x 95"	59 fat eighths 25 fat quarters 30 1/4 yards 88 2.5" x WOF strips	Binding - 5/8 yards Backing - 5 3/4 yards Batting - 72" x 101"
FULL SIZE	85.5" x 95"	33 fat quarters 38 1/4 yards 113 2.5" x WOF strips 18 Half yards	Binding - 3/4 yards Backing - 8 yards Batting - 91" x 110"
QUEEN SIZE	95" x 114"	43 fat quarters 50 1/4 yards 150 2.5" x WOF strips 22 Half yards	Binding - 7/8 yards Backing - 8 5/8 yards Batting - 101" x 120"
KING SIZE	114" x 114"	52 fat quarters 60 1/4 yards 180 2.5" x WOF strips 26 Half yards	Binding - 7/8 yards Backing - 10 1/4 yards Batting - 120" x 120"

*Fat quarter cuts are precise. Add a few additional fat quarters to cover any cutting errors or mis-cut fat quarters.

**Backing includes 4in overage

Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric Shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips

- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- 10” or larger square ruler
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers; I like the following sizes:
 - 6” x 24”
 - 4” x 14”
- Cutting mat: 18” x 24” is a good size

Additional Supplies:

- Creative Grids 15” Seam Guide Tool, or a similar ½” marking ruler
- Mechanical pencil, Frixion pen, or fabric pen/pencil with a fine point

Optional Supplies:

- Woolly Felted Wonders Pressing Bar and Clapper (the 12” size is sufficient), OR The Strip Stick (Both items will allow you to press seams open more easily.)
- Spray starch, Best Press, Flatter, or your favorite starch alternative
- Tailor’s clapper
- Rotating cutting mat big enough for a 10” square ruler

Sewing Machine, etc.:

- Sewing machine in working order
- ¼” patchwork foot, if you have
- Sewing machine needles, size 80/12 sharp or universal

I would encourage you to purchase your pattern ahead of time, especially if you are cutting your strips from stash or yardage. Cutting diagrams are listed on p. 3 of the pattern. Feel free to go ahead and cut your strips prior to class if you are comfortable.

*****NOTE:** If cutting strips from stash, cut strips slightly longer than 21” as listed on pattern; 21-1/2” or 22” in length is ideal.
