- Sewing machine and needle (A microtex needle is a good choice but not necessary if you don't have one.)
- neutral thread
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- small cutting mat for use at your personal work station
- Add-a Quarter ruler
- scotch tape
- glue stick and/or flower head pin (1)
- postcard
- other assorted sewing supplies that you like to use while piecing. Dare I say a seam ripper?

## How to Prep for Class

## "Love Your Neighbor"

- 1. Purchase "Love Your Neighbor" by Rebecca Ruth Designs. We have the pattern in stock at The Old Country Store. Please plan to get your own pattern rather than sharing with a friend.
- 2. Using the back of the pattern envelope, gather/purchase your fabrics.
- **3.** Make copies of your paper piecing patterns. Recommended not to avoid using regular copy paper. Instead use Carol Doak's Foundation Paper (available at the Old Country Store) or other papers made for paper piecing. Newsprint in 8 1/2" by 11" will also work well. (Copy paper can be difficult to remove.)
