# Counted Cross Stitch Finishing Student Supply List

# **Counted Cross Stitch Piece**

Please bring at least one completed counted cross stitch piece that is ready for finishing.

# **Miscellaneous Finishing Supplies:**

- Fabric Scissors
- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic rulers
- Fabric pen/pencil
- Hand needle & thread
- Thimble

Depending on how you plan to finish your project, you'll need the following supplies:

#### Flat Finishes:

- Mounting board or "sticky board" (I prefer plain mounting board that I get at Hobby Lobby.)
- Fabric to cover backing board
- Aleene's Original Tacky Glue
- Lacing supplies:
  - o Button and craft thread or DMC Perle Cotton #8
  - o Doll or embroidery needle suitable for your thread
- Double stick craft tape (optional)
- Ribbon for bow(s)
- Covered button supplies

## **Framed Finishes**

- Frame to fit your cross stitch piece
- Craft or scrapbook paper to cover back of frame if necessary
- Supplies listed above for flat finishes

## **Bowl Fillers/Small Pillows**

- Muslin or neutral fabric to line your cross stitch piece
- Coordinating fabric for back of pillow
- Stuffing:
  - o Polyfil, or
  - o Poly pellets, or
  - Crushed walnut shells
- Felt or wool scraps to embellish back (optional)

#### **Pillows**

- Fabric for back of pillow
- Fabric for binding, if desired
- Zipper, if desired
- Pillow form, or supplies to make custom pillow form:
  - Fabric for pillow form
  - High loft batting to line inside of pillow form
  - Polyfil stuffing

If you plan to stitch bowl fillers or a pillow, you'll need the following:

- Sewing machine in working order, or you may borrow a classroom machine
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your project
- Zipper foot if using a zipper

I will have an assortment of miscellaneous supplies (mounting board, batting, stuffing, etc.) that you are welcome to cash purchase from me the day of class if you aren't quite sure how you want to finish your project or exactly what you'll need.

You'll have plenty of time to run over to the store for fabric supplies for finishing during class as well.
