Clam Up Zippered Pouches Student Supply List

Pattern: byAnnie Clam Up Zippered Pouches pattern

Fabric & Notions: as listed on back of pattern

Basic Sewing Kit

- Thread in neutral shade to match fabric: Aurifil 50 wt or Superior So Fine works well.
- Pins
- Fabric shears
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper

Sewing Machine, etc.

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot with guide bar
- 1/4" piecing foot
- zipper foot
- overcast foot or a foot that will allow you to stitch a zig zag stitch
- Teflon foot (optional, if using iron-on vinyl laminate for the inside of your bag)
- 90/14 Microtex or Topstitch needle

Rotary Cutting Supplies

- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic rulers my favorite sizes:
 - 4" x 14"
 - 6" x 24"
- Cutting mat, 18" x 24" (optional)

Misc Tools & Notions

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Clover Chaco Liner (white only!)
- Hera marker
- Clover Tailor's Awl or stiletto
- Machine quilting gloves, optional
- Template plastic or manilla file folder to create bag templates: Template plastic is ideal for fussy cutting fabric; otherwise, a manilla folder works just fine.
- Paper scissors

Additional Notes:

• I'm sure you'll want to stitch all five sizes (it's so fun to make the entire set!), but I would suggest you start with the medium size or larger to learn the techniques.

- Please cut your fabrics prior to class using the chart on p. 2 of the pattern. If you are using a directional print, you may want to wait until the day class for me to show you how to make that work. I would suggest holding off on cutting out the clam shape until after our class instruction.
- We will have plenty of time in class to do the walking foot quilting.
- Be sure to photocopy your pattern templates before class so that you don't ruin the template on the opposite side when cutting out.
- You will need to use a #4.5 byAnnie or #5 handbag zipper (vs. a #3 apparel zipper)* for the bags to come together properly. Here are some options:
 - I used Sallie Tomato #5 zipper tape for my samples plus the flower pulls; they are sold in packages with three yards of zipper tape and nine zipper pulls. One package plus one extra pull is enough for all five bags. Or, simply use just one pull for one of the bags and two for the rest.
 - One pack of #4.5 byAnnie Zippers by the yard will yield enough zipper tape and pulls for all five bags, plus some leftover.
 - Or purchase individual double slide zippers for the size bag you plan to stitch.
 - Or, you can simply use a single slide zipper vs. a double slide.

*Keep in mind that the #4.5 byAnnie zipper pulls are <u>**not**</u> interchangeable with #5 handbag zippers and vice versa.
