

Winslet Wallet Supply List:

Pattern: You will need to purchase the Winslet Wallet Pattern – this pattern is ONLY available as a PDF download from *Hold-It-Right-There* : <https://holditpatterns.com/product/winslet-wallet-sewing-pattern/>

Fabric and Interfacing as per recommended in the pattern:

- **Fabric #1:** ½ yard 44" quilt weight cotton (*Exterior Flap, Flap Lining, Interior Panel, Card Pockets, Zipper Tab*)
- **Fabric #2:** Fat Quarter lightweight canvas, linen blend, or quilt weight cotton (*Interior Flap, Exterior Panel, Slip Pockets*)
 - You can use more than two fabrics for this wallet depending upon the style you are going for. Sometimes I like to mix and match fat quarters.
- Coordinating Polyester Thread
 - There is quite a bit of topstitching throughout the wallet construction, so you may want more than one color.
- 1 yard Pellon SF-101 woven interfacing
 - Having a little extra can be helpful
- ¼ yd Pellon 72F Peltex Two Sided Fusible Ultra Firm Stabilizer

Hardware as per recommended in the pattern:

- One ¾" or ½" magnetic snap
- One (8" or longer zipper)
 - NOTE: I use a 7 inch metal zipper and it works perfectly.
 - You can also use a Nylon Zipper By the Yard. I recommend Sallie Tomato Brand either the #3 size or the #5 size.
- 2 ¼" length of ¾" elastic
- If you want to add a wristlet strap, you will need one ½" D-Ring and one ½" swivel hook

Tools and Notions:

- Cutting Mat (I like to use 18x24)
- Rotary cutter
- Long Ruler (I like to use 6 x 24)
- Small square ruler (I like to use 4.5" square)
- Pins
- Clips
- Seam Ripper
- Fabric scissors
- A small pair of sharp scissors with a point
- Fabric gluestick
- Stiletto
- Tailors Chalk (if using dark fabrics)
- Disappearing ink pen for marking on fabric
- Dritz Fray Check

Sewing Machine:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Regular sewing foot attachment for the sewing machine
- Zipper foot attachment for the sewing machine
- Walking foot for the sewing machine is helpful for the final bag assembly not required
- Size 90/14 sewing machine needle

Before Class:

Please have all fabric and interfacing cut BEFORE class. You will need to pay close attention to the flap directions as you are cutting and interfacing mirrored images. If you are unsure of how to cut certain pieces, I can assist you in class.

The pattern pieces must be print at 100% scale. There is a tester box on the page for you to measure to ensure it is printed at the proper scale.

The cutting instructions we will be using are on page 10. However, the pattern also offers paper templates for all of the pieces if you would prefer to use those instead of following the cutting instructions. They are on pages 16-22. I have found it is faster to use only the paper templates for the flap, and then following the cutting instructions for the rest of the pieces.
