**Fabric Requirements\* (as listed on pattern):**

Vintage Lace is inspired by the delicate intricacies of a beautiful, old piece of lace.  
 Pattern assumes WOF to be 42".  
 Fat Quarter (FQ): 18" x 21"  
 Fat Eighth (F8): 9" x 21"  
 Skill Level: Confident Beginner

REQUIREMENTS**

	Baby <i>48" x 48"</i>	Throw <i>72" x 72"</i>	Bed <i>108" x 108"</i>
<b>Color 1</b>	1/4 yard or 1 F8	1/4 yard or 1 F8	3/8 yard
<b>Color 2</b>	1/4 yard or 1 F8	1/4 yard or 1 F8	3/8 yard
<b>Color 3</b>	1/4 yard or 1 F8	1/4 yard or 1 F8	3/8 yard
<b>Color 4</b>	1/2 yard or 1 FQ	1/2 yard or 2 FQ	1 yard
<b>Color 5</b>	1/2 yard or 1 FQ	1/2 yard or 2 FQ	1 yard
<b>Color 6</b>	1/4 yard or 1 FQ	1/2 yard or 2 FQ	3/4 yard
<b>Color 7</b>	1/2 yard or 2 FQ	3/4 yard or 3 FQ	1-1/3 yard
<b>Back-ground</b>	2-1/4 yards	4 yards	8-1/4 yards
<b>Backing</b>	3 yards	4-1/2 yards	9-3/4 yards
<b>Binding</b>	1/2 yard	2/3 yard	7/8 yard

	Baby	Throw	Bed
<b>Color 1</b>	1-1/4 yards or 5 FQ	2 yards or 10 FQ	4-1/2 yards
<b>Back-ground</b>	2-1/4 yards	4 yards	8-1/4 yards
<b>Backing</b>	3 yards	4-1/2 yards	9-3/4 yards
<b>Binding</b>	1/2 yard	2/3 yard	7/8 yard

**Basic Sewing Kit:**

- Fabric Shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

**Rotary Cutting Supplies:**

- Depending on the size quilt you are planning to make, you will need either a **Bloc Loc Half Square Triangle Ruler** OR a **square ruler** (I am loving the Quilter's Select Rulers!):
  - Baby: 2.5" square ruler or larger
  - Throw: 3.5" square ruler or larger
  - Bed: 5" square ruler or larger(I will be demonstrating both rulers. Feel free to wait until the day of class to purchase your ruler after you see my demonstration.)
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers; I like the following sizes:
  - 6" x 24"
  - 4" x 14"
- Cutting mat: 18" x 24" is a good size

**Additional Supplies:**

- Frixiion pen or fine tip marking pencil
- 1/2" marking ruler:
  - Creative Grids 15" Seam Guide Tool (my favorite), **OR**
  - Fons and Porter 1/4" Seam Marker, **OR**
  - Studio 180 Quilters Magic Wand, **OR**
  - Omnigrd 4", 6", and 12" Marking Ruler Trio

**Optional Supplies:**

- Wooly Felted Wonders Pressing Bar and Clapper (the 12" size is sufficient), OR The Strip Stick (Both items will allow you to press seams open more easily.)
- Spray starch, Best Press, Flatter, or your favorite starch alternative
- Tailor's clapper
- Clover Tailor's Awl
- Rotating cutting mat

**Sewing Machine, etc.:**

- Sewing machine in working order
- 1/4" patchwork foot, if you have
- Sewing machine needles, size 80/12 sharp or universal

**\*Note:** If you wish to make the Sage Modern Version as pictured on The Old Country Store class website and Lo & Behold's blog/Instagram account, below are the Kona cotton colors needed:

1. Pomegranate – ¼ yd.
2. Camellia – ¼ yd.
3. Melon – ¼ yd.
4. Primrose – ½ yd.
5. Bellini – ½ yd.
6. Shell – ½ yd.
7. Everglade – ¾ yd.
8. Sage (background) – 4 yds.

The *Modern Version* shown on the pattern uses Bordeaux, Valentine, Camellia, Dusty Peach, Grelow, Leather, Yarrow, and Snow.

The *Traditional Version* uses Snow and Doeskin.

Please cut your fabrics prior to class so that we can get right to sewing all those half square triangles!
