

## Fall Leaves Student Supply List

### Pattern:

*Fall Leaves* quilt pattern by Cluck Cluck Sew

### Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

### Additional Supplies:

- Cluck Cluck Sew Diagonal Seam Tape, or
- Frixion pen or fine tip fabric marking pencil and small ruler for drawing diagonal lines on your fabric squares

### Optional Supplies:

- Pressing station (iron and pressing board) – this is a lot of pressing as you go, so you might enjoy being able to press at your work station. I will have pressing boards available for purchase if you are interested.
- Wool pressing bar

### Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers: I like the following sizes:
  - 6" x 22"
  - 4" x 14"
  - 1" x 6" or 2-1/2 x 6-1/2"
- Cutting mat: 18" x 24" is a good size

### Sewing Machine, etc:

- Sewing machine in working order
- 1/4" patchwork foot
- Sewing machine needles

### Fabric Requirements (as listed on pattern):

\*I used an “inspiration” print to select 25 the different leaf fabrics from my stash as well as the background fabric.

Please cut your fabrics prior to class so that you will have plenty of time for sewing during our time together. Or, if you want some guidance with cutting, feel free to wait until class to cut your fabrics. I found the Stripology ruler to be helpful for subcuts. Also, be sure to pay attention to the cutting diagram in the pattern: the 2 1/2” x 5 1/4” leaf rectangles should run the opposite direction as the rest of the leaf rectangles; this is especially important if you are using a directional print.

I love Cluck Cluck Sew’s patterns, and I know you will enjoy making this quilt as much as I did - looking forward to stitching with you!
