Bernina Embroidery Club – October 2023 Accessory Bag Supply List



During this class we will construct an accessory bag to carry your electronic device attachments (e.g., charger, flash drives, external drive, etc.), sewing/embroidery tools, or whatever else you'd like to keep organized in one bag. We will practice loading and placing embroidery designs and adding a word, if you choose.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class, having completed any prerequisite steps listed. Regarding fabric choice, cotton fabric works best. You may choose several fabrics to make your cover scrappy or coordinated. Use your creativity in selecting, just make sure you have fabric for all pieces. The front cover will be where we embroider so keep that in mind when selecting. On the sample, I used one fabric for the outside and one for the lining.

Fabric for outside, zipper tabs, and loop: (sample is greenish)

- 2 10" wide x 9" high for outside
- 1-2" x 9" for zipper tabs and loop. Press in half (1" x 9"), then press raw 9" edges into the fold to make a $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" piece with long raw edges hidden. Do <u>not</u> stitch closed.

Fabric for lining: (sample is pale lavender)

• 2 – 10" wide x 9" high

Fabric for heart: (sample is lavender)

• 1-5" wide x 4" high. This can be a scrap, but this is the minimum size.

Stabilizer:

Medium Weight Tear Away, 1 – 10" x 14" OR Ultra Clean & Tear, 2 – 10" x 14".
 If you want to stitch something on the back, you will need twice this as the above is to stitch on one side.

Pellon Fusible Thermolan Plus 971F, 2 – 11" x 10". Center, press, and quilt this
to the wrong side of the outside pieces. You can stitch on a diagonal 1" apart or
use a quilt pattern if you choose. This should be done before coming to class.





Embroidery bobbin thread

Thread to sew bag together. Match to cover fabric (greenish/lavender in sample), same thread for bobbin. You could use Isacord or Metler.

Zipper – 14" nylon coil (not metal) zipper. Also should not be invisible type.

Needle – Embroidery 75/11

Threads for Design:

These are the Isacord colors used in the sample. You may take liberty in using other colors to coordinate with the fabric you choose.

- 2830 Basting box
- 2830 Placement stitch
- 2830 Blanket stitch
- 5513 Leaves and thread cones
- 0630 Yellow cross stitch
- 0630 Yellow thread
- 5100 Blue thread
- 2550 Light flower petals
- 2520 Dark flower petals
- 0630 Flower centers
- 2550 Pink buttons
- 5100 Blue pinheads and cross stitch
- 0111 Outline
- 0124 Needle
- 2520 Thread in needle

Feet - #26 (embroidery), #37/57/97C or D (quarter inch), #20C or D, #4/4D

Hoop – Large Oval or Midi, your choice

Stitch plate – Regular 9mm and single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

Other:

Rotary cutter
Scissors for thread
Straight pins
Ruler with 45 degree line on it
Fabric marking you can see on your fabric
Stiletto
Straight pins
Paper scissors
Small Cutting mat
