

## Embroidered Winter Gift Bags



### Supply list:

You will need to purchase one of the following designs:

*Winter Magic Ice Skates Etching*

from Embroidery Library ([www.emblibrary.com](http://www.emblibrary.com)) Product ID: ESP81932-1

*Cardinal & Magnolias*

From OESD ([www.embroideryonline.com](http://www.embroideryonline.com)) Product ID: FQ664\_48

***Please load the design onto your machine before the day of the class. If you have any questions, please call me and I will help.***

***Also, please bring your color change sheet from Embroidery Library to use for guidance with your color choice.***

*If you have time at the end of the class, you are welcome to start a second bag. My phone number: 610-780-6756*

### Fabric:

- 3/4 yd. Of top fabric
- 1/2 yd. Of lining fabric
- Scrap fabric for the decorative top (it will measure 13x3 – You will need 2 of the same color)
- Ribbon to match your bag. At least 84"
- *You will have extra fabric.*

### Stabilizer:

- 18-inch X 18-inch Fusible cut away – I used OESD
- 14-inch X 18-inch Light tear away – I used OESD
- 14-inch X 16-inch Medium tear away – I used OESD
- Extra stabilizer may be needed – I recommend bring your rolls

### Embroidery Thread:

- Isacord or Mettler Poly Sheen work well Cardinal & Magnolias  
5 greens for the leaves – I used 5833, 352, 5934, 465, 6133  
5 colors for the flower – I used 15, 781, 170, 731, 640,
- 8 colors for the bird – I used 1010, 4174, 20, 1725, 1913, 1600, 2123, &15
- *These colors can be traded out for your own taste. I used what OESD suggested.*

### Ice Skates

- 3 colors for the skates – I used 15, 1061, 1876
- 5 colors for the flowers/pinecones/greens - 5233, 941, 922, 2640, & 1876
- *These colors can be traded out for your own taste. I used what Embroidery Library suggested.*

### **Bobbin Thread**

- Seraline – please have bobbin thread rewound.

### **Needles:**

- Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. *I recommend the Microtex 90/14.*

### **Embroidery machine**

- Bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.
  - Feet
  - - #26 (embroidery), Walking foot, 97C or 97D.
  - Steam a seam 2 1/4 inch
  - Hoop
- Midi Hoop or Large Embroidery Hoop, your choice.

### **Stitch plate**

- single hole 0mm (if you have one) and regular 9mm.

### **Other:**

Midi Hoop or Large Embroidery Hoop, your choice.

Stitch plate – single-hole 0mm (if you have one) and regular 9mm.

Wonder clips or straight pins

Point turner

Seam ripper

Bobbin by Clover or a large safety pin

Temporary Marker that can be seen or pencil

Thread snips

Flash drive to load project designs

Rotary cutter

Tweezers

Small ruler – I used 6" x 12"

Large ruler – I used 6" x 24"

Fabric scissors
