Feed Sacks Supply List

To make a medium bag (like the store sample):

Pattern is called Feed Sacks by Joanna Figueroa, Fig Tree & Co., available at The Old Country Store.

Moda Crossweave is used in this pattern for the bottom and handles, but Essex Linen can be a substitute.

For medium bag: 20–2 inch strips (2 sets)

5/8 of yard for lining

1/2 yard for bottom and straps

1 yard of fusible fleece —for bag and lining

*optional 15 inches x WOF Light fusible interfacing is used to quilt the bag. I did not use this.

Thread for piecing the bag and thread for topstitching if a different color is preferred.

Please have your (20) 2 x 12.5 inch strips ONLY pre-cut for class. This is 2 sets of 10 strips—one set for the front and one for the back. After cutting your strips, please bring the extra fabric to class. Thank you!

Please make your paper template as described in the pattern for the medium bag cutout.
