

BERNINA Embroidery Club – November 2023
Holiday Greeting Supply List
An “In the Hoop” Embroidery Project

During this class we will explore several ways to embroider a greeting on cardstock. This will facilitate evaluation of necessary supplies based on desired finished project. The project is completed in the hoop.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class. Regarding fabric choice, quilter’s cotton fabric works best. Please bring enough supplies to make several cards, as time should allow for you to practice what you learned or to experiment with another method.

As cardstock quality varies, I will provide a kit with three white premade cards and envelopes. I will also have white cardstock available to cut to size if you chose that method. This will eliminate the chance of a failed project due to the cardstock chosen. Kits will be \$1.00. You can try other cardstock at home, including homemade cardstock which usually has a unique texture, but in class we’ll use a known product.

Fabric for applique:

Three of the cards stitch best with fabric due to the stitch density. Bring fabric at least 5” x 7” for each. We will trim it in class.

- Let it Snow – sample is off-white
- Together – sample is off-white
- Peace – sample is blue

Stabilizers:

We will be discussing various ways of making cards. Stabilizers used in the process include the following. You will not need all of them, but bring your rolls of what you have so you can try several methods.

- Stable-Stick Tear Away
- Ultra Clean & Tear
- Fusible Woven
- Fuse and Fleece
- Fusible Polymesh

Isacord Threads:

Threads listed are what was used in the samples. Be creative in your choices.

Let it Snow –

- 1755 – fabric tackdown and pink detail
- 3030 – purple detail
- 4133 – dark blue detail
- 4752 – light blue detail



Together –

- 3030 – fabric tackdown and purple detail
- 1755 – pink detail
- 4752 – light blue detail
- 5743 – medium green detail
- 1600 – red detail
- 5555 – dark green detail
- 4133 – dark blue lettering and house detail
- 0101 – white detail
- 1134 – brown detail



Peace –

- ???? – thread to match your fabric
- 0015 – border, words, and leaves
- 7009 – IF you want to try the border with metallic thread

Ornaments –

- 3901 – blue for waves at bottom
- 1911 – red for ornaments



Embroidery bobbin thread – e.g., Seralene or Bottom Line. I would suggest white.

Needle – Embroidery 75/11, Metallic needle IF you want to try metallic thread on Peace

Spray adhesive 505

Embroidery machine – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

Feet - #26 (embroidery)

Hoop – Large Oval or Midi

Stitch plate – Single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

Other:

Scissors for thread

Ruler

Rotary cutter

Permanent glue stick (fresh) or double-sided scotch tape

Scrapbooking paper for inside of card. This can be done after class.

Painter's tape
