To be purchased online.

- This is a custom class. Please find a NIKE logo on the site listed below and bring it on your flash drive.
- Please keep in mind there will be designs you do not like. Just scroll by them and look for something that fits your personality. I made my sweatshirt for my granddaughter with a baseball logo and her team's name on her sleeve.
- www.Embropedia.com In the search engine type in "Nike Logo"
 - They have hundreds to choose from.

Also, please bring your color change sheet from Embropedia to use for guidance with your color choice and assembly.

Fabric

- You do not need to bring any fabric, just bring a sweatshirt. Advanced students may consider bringing an extra sweatshirt to work on once they've finished their first.
 - Please prewash your sweatshirt before bringing to class.
- If you have an embroidery software program, please print your designs. If you don't, that's okay we will go over how to center your design without the printed design.

Stabilizer

- Medium tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Fusible Woven stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Stitch H2O water stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Gentle Touch Backing – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.

Thread

- Bring a variety of threads including all the colors needed for the front of your sweatshirt and sleeve.

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

Needles: - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. *I recommend the Microtex 90/14.*

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot) 97, 97C, or 97D

Hoop: - Medium hoop, large hoop or midi hoop

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

Other:

Small old towel or drop cloth

Thread snips

small and large ruler

Flash drive to load projects

Straight pins

Fabric scissors

Your machine manual

Paper for taking notes

Temporary Marker or pencil

Tweezers

paper scissors

rotary cutter

paper scissors

seam ripper
