## Singer Featherweight Club

## December 2023: Cups and Saucers and Crystal Star

## Supply List

1. Singer 221 "Featherweight" sewing machine in good working order
2. Thread in a neutral color
3. Rotary Cutter
4. *Ruler ( 6 " $\times 12$ " or $61 / 2 " \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ ") I prefer this size because it allows you to place your whole hand on the ruler for stability. You may use whatever size with which you are comfortable.
5. *Studio 180 Tucker Trimmer I and a $* 121 / 2 "$ inch ruler for squaring up blocks

OR
*Studio 180 Tucker Trimmer III
6. *Studio 180 Magic Wand or other tool for marking one-quarter inch seams such as the *Creative Grids Seam Guide Tool or *Fons and Porter's Quarter Inch Seam Marker
7. Tool for sewing a quarter-inch seam. If you have the vintage seam guide that came with your machine, you may use that. Other options are the seam guide and square (available at The Old Country Store) or a quarter-inch foot (available at singer-featherweight.com.) Tape is not recommended for use on Featherweights because it will damage the protective clear coat.
8. If you are using a cross-wound thread such as Aurifil, a *thread stand or *thread post is recommended to prevent the thread from twisting.
9. Basic sewing supplies: pins, small scissors, seam ripper, etc.
10. Marking pen or pencil
11. *Studio 180 Designs Wing Clipper Ruler

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## Fabric Requirements

## Cups and Saucers

There are multiple color options for this block. You may use 2, 3, or 4 colors. If you want to use 4 colors, as in the sample, you will need:

Background:
Corners: Two 5" x 5" squares
Flying geese units: Eight 3" x 3" squares
Center and corners (Shown in green):
Center: One $41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ square


## Corners: Two 5 " x 5 " squares

Inner and outer flying geese units (pink) Two $51 / 2 " \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " squares. You may use two different prints as shown, or one print. You may also use two different colors if you wish.

## Crystal Star

This block also has multiple color options. You may choose to make it in 2 colors or 3, as shown in the sample. If you want to use 3 colors you will need:

Background:
Corners: Four $31 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ squares
Star point flying geese units: One $71 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ square (white)
Center flying geese units: Four $4 " \times 4 "$ squares (white)


Star Points: Four $4 \times 4$ squares (red)
Center: One $71 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ square. Use a dense print if you do not want the center line to show.
Note: You will have two flying geese units left over after making the center of the block.
