During this class we will learn how to embroider on a knit cap. As the weave of knit caps varies greatly, I will provide the beanie caps so we're all working on the same weave. The caps will cost approximately \$6 each. Please bring cash along to class to purchase the beanie cap.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class.

Stabilizers:

- OESD PolyMesh Cut-away 1, 8" x 10"
- OESD Stitch H2O 1, 8" x 10"

Isacord Threads:

Pick thread colors you want. I've requested the beanie caps in gray. If they don't all come in gray, other colors could be navy or black. The following colors are for

reference only to the sample.

•	Light green	5832	0453
•	White	0015	2171
•	Dark green	5933	0465

Embroidery bobbin thread – e.g., Seralene or Bottom Line. I would suggest white.

Needle – Jersey 80/12

Embroidery machine – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

Feet - #26 (embroidery)

Hoop – Medium

Stitch plate – Single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

Other:

Scissors for thread Marker that can be seen on beanie

Rotary cutter Wonder Clips, large (to clip beanie into nest)

Ruler
