Embroidered Custom Banner

Supply list:

Fabric

- You will need 2 8.5" x 8.5" canvas cloth for each letter.
- You will need canvas cloth.
- I purchased 2 yards of canvas cloth for 7 letters, 2 end pieces and binding. I had very little fabric left.
 - o If you plan on making end pieces, please stitch them out on a 8.5"x 8.5" canvas cloth **before** coming to class. As you will not have time to stitch them out the day of.

Stabilizer

- Medium tear away stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll.
- Hydro stick stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll.
- Light tear away stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll

Thread

 Bring a variety of threads that you plan on using for the letters on your banner. You will also need the thread color you plan on using for the edge stitching and binding.

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

Bring extra bobbins as the letters use a lot of thread

Needles: - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. I recommend the Microtex 90/14.

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot) #97, #97C, or #97D, #10 edge foot

Hoop: - Medium hoop

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

Other:

Small old towel or drop cloth Temporary Marker or pencil

Thread snips Tweezers

small and large ruler

Straight pins paper scissors
Fabric scissors seam ripper
Your machine manual Press cloth
Paper for taking notes rotary cutter

We will be using a pattern from Bernina (weallsew) Celebration Banner Tutorial - WeAllSew
