Throw 64" x 64" and
Double 87" x 87"

## SUPPLY LIST

- Pattern - Abby’s Puzzle by Lynn Weatley of Lynn Weatley Design (available at the Old Country Store)
- Mini Quick Curve Ruler - by Sew Kind of Wonderful (available at the Old Country Store)
- Tucker Trimmer 1 - Studio 180 Design (available at the Old Country Store)
- Quilter's Magic Wand or another 1/4" seam guide (available at the Old Country Store)


## Basic Sewing and Quilting Supplies -

- Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot, a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
- Seam ripper
- Scissor snips
- Extra fine pins - Clover Patchwork Extra Fine Pins or Magic Pins - extra fine
- Small cutting mat - 12 " x 12 " or larger
- Rotary Cutter with a new blade **
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixon pen or marking pencil such as Sewline)
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for back of tools
- Tweezers *** VERY IMPORTANT
**NOTE: ROTARY CUTTER most 28mm and 45mm work best with Mini Quick Curve Ruler. 60 mm is to big. Check the rotary cutter to make sure the blade sticks out at least as thick as the ruler.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS
Abby's Puzzle - 6 Fabrics and a Background
When selecting fabrics, there should be contrast between Fabrics $1 \& 6$, and Fabrics $2 \& 5$. Fabrics 3 \& 4 can be similar or different.
I selected an Analogous color plan, green/blue/purple, but this would also work with a Split Complimentary plan, with Fabric 3 \& 4 as an accent and across the color wheel from Fabrics 1, 2, 5 \& 6. Just remember to check your contrast between Fabrics 1 \& 6, and Fabrics 2 \& 5.

## Fabric Yardage:

Based on 40 " of useable fabric with a few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

| Fabric 5 - Medium Shown in Green | $3 / 8$ Yard | 3/4 Yard | $11 / 4$ Yards |
| Fabric 6 - Medium Light Shown in Teal | 1/2 Yard | 7/8 Yard | $11 / 2$ Yards |
| Background | $13 / 4$ Yards | $31 / 4$ Yards | $51 / 2$ Yards |
| Binding - Quilters Choice Shown in Yellow Floral on Multi | $3 / 8$ Yard | 1/2 Yard | 5/8 Yard |
| Backing | 3 Yards | 4 Yards | 8 Yards |

Minimum Pre-cutting for Class: this will allow you to complete 1 each of four different Blocks. (QC - Quick Curve, QST - Quarter Square Triangle, HST - Half Square Triangle)

| Fabric 2 - Medium Dark Shown in Medium Purple | QC3 | (1) 6 " $\times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (2) 6 " squares |
|  | QST2 | (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (1) $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Fabric 3 - Medium <br> Shown in Yellow Dragon Fly on Multi | HST1 | (1) $41 / 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (8) $411 / 2 \prime$ squares |
| Fabric 4 - Medium <br> Shown in Yellow Floral on Multi | HST2 | (1) $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (8) $411 / 2 \prime$ squares |
| Fabric 5 - Medium | QC4 | (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (2) $6^{\prime \prime}$ squares |


| Shown in Green | QST2 | (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (1) $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares |

| Fabric 6 - Medium Light Shown in Teal | QC2 | (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (2) $6^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
|  | QST1 | (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (1) $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Background | HST1 \& HST2 | (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub cut into (8) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares Assign (4) $41 / 2 \prime 2$ squares to each HST1 \& HST2 |
|  | $\begin{gathered} \text { QC1, QC2, QC3 \& } \\ \text { QC4 } \end{gathered}$ | (1) 7 " x WOF strip, sub cut into (8) 4 " $\times 7$ " rectangles Assign (2) 4" $\times 7$ " rectangles to each QC1, QC2, QC3 \& QC4 |

Getting Organized!!! Separate above fabrics onto paper plates or into ziplock bags and label QC1, QC2, QC3, QC4, HST1, HST2, QST1 and QST2.
