

## SUPPLY LIST

- Pattern - Ring Around The Four - Patch by Katrina Thomas of The Hope Chest (available at the Old Country Store)
- Tucker Trimmer 1 OR Pint Size Tucker Trimmer - Studio 180 Design (available at the Old Country Store)
- Quilter's Magic Wand or another 1/4" seam guide (available at the Old Country Store)


## Basic Sewing and Quilting Supplies -

- Sewing Machine with $1 / 4$ " foot, a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread - 50 wt is good for piecing
- Seam ripper
- Scissor snips
- Extra fine pins - Clover Patchwork Extra Fine Pins or Magic Pins - extra fine
- Small cutting mat - 12" x 12" or larger
- Rotary Cutter with a new blade
- Marking pen or pencil - (frixon pen or marking pencil such as Sewline)
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for back of tools
- Stiletto or Purple thing to help guide small patches while stitching

Fabric Requirements.
Scrappy Design Fabric Requirements: Fabric Selection - I recommend using lots of different fabrics - the More the Merrier! In this sample 64 different medium to dark fabrics were used to create this scrappy design.

Based on 40 " of useable fabric with a few cutting errors. Please plan according.

| Fabric | Qty |
| :--- | :---: |
| Assorted Medium to Dark Scraps | $1 / 2$ Yard total |
| Light Scraps (can be 1 or many fabrics) | $3 / 8$ Yard total |
| $1^{\text {st }}$ Border (can be the same as light scraps) | $1 / 8$ Yard |
| $2^{\text {nd }}$ Border | $1 / 4$ Yard |
| Binding | $1 / 4$ to $3 / 8$ Yard |
| Backing | 22 " square |



## "RING AROUND THE FOUR - PATCH"

Scrappy Design - FULL CUTTING DIRECTIONS

| FABRIC | CUT |
| :---: | :---: |
| Dark/Med Scraps | 32-2 1/2" x $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles 32-1 1/2" $\times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles |
| Light Scraps | 32-2 1/2" $\times 3$ 1/2" rectangles |
| 1st Border | 2-1" strips $\times$ WOF |
| 2nd Border | 2-2" strips x WOF |
| Binding | 2 strips $\times$ WOF Width is determined by size of binding that you choose to make. I chose to make $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Binding with $11 / 4$ " strips. |

## Scrappy Design - Minimum precutting for Class, cut:

## Medium to Dark Scraps:

- (16) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangles
- (16) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " rectangles

Light Scraps:

- (16) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangles

Bring your extra fabrics to class.

## 2 Colorway Design Option:

Fabric Selection - I recommend starting with your border and selecting 2 dominant colors for the radiating rings. Then you have an option to use a third color or float the center by using the background fabric for the $1^{\text {st }}$ border

## 2 Colorway Design Fabric Requirements:

Based on 40" of useable fabric with a few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

| Fabric | Qty |
| :--- | :---: |
| Color 1 - Solid radiating bands, <br> shown in green | $1 / 4$ Yard |
| Color 2 - Square chain bands, <br> shown in pink | $1 / 4$ Yard |
| Light Background | $3 / 8$ Yard |
| 1st Border | $1 / 8$ Yard |
| $2^{\text {nd }}$ Border | $1 / 4$ Yard |
| Binding | $1 / 4$ to $3 / 8$ Yard |
| Backing | $22^{\prime \prime}$ square |

2 Colorway Design - FULL CUTTING DIRECTIONS

| FABRIC | CUT |
| :--- | :--- |
| Color 1 - for the solid radiating bands | $32-21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangles |
| Color 2 - for the square chain bands | $32-11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangles |
| Light Background | $32-21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangles |
| 1st Border | $2-1 "$ strips x WOF |
| 2nd Border | $2-2 "$ strips x WOF |
| Binding | 2 strips x WOF. Width is determined by size of binding that <br> you choose to make. I chose to make a $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Binding with 1 <br> $1 / 4 " ~ s t r i p s . ~$ |

## 2 Colorway Defsign - Minimum Precutting for Class, cut:

Color 1 for the solid radiating bands:

- (16) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2$ " rectangles

Color 2 for the square chain bands:

- (16) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " rectangles

Light Background:

- (16) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangles
