Fabric

- Fabric needed: Please see pillow picture for guidance
 - Pillow measures 16 x 16"
 - 1 yard of linen will make one pillow

Pillow Insert

- Old Country Store carries pillow inserts
 - Remember you can receive a 10% discount for this item if purchased for the class.

Stabilizer

- Medium and Heavy tear away stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll. I used
 one layer of medium and one layer of heavy when stitching out this design.
- Fusible Woven stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll.

Thread

Bring a variety of threads including all the colors needed for the completion of your pillow. Refer
to the pillow design color chart for suggested colors. But please use your own creative flow
when choosing your colors.

Bobbin Thread:

Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

Bobbin Case:

- If you have a yellow bobbin case it is highly recommended that you bring this to class.
- You will also be using your black bobbin case for the sewing portion of this project.

Needles: -

Microtex 80/12

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

- Feet: #26 (embroidery foot)
- Feet: # 97, 97C, 97D (1/4 inch foot)

Hoop: - Large Hoop – If you use this hoop you will have to hoop several times

Maxi Hoop – I used this hoop for the entire embroidered design

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

Small old towel or drop cloth

Thread snips small and large ruler Flash drive to load projects

Straight pins Fabric scissors
