

BERNINA Embroidery Club – April 2024 Spring Pillow Supply List

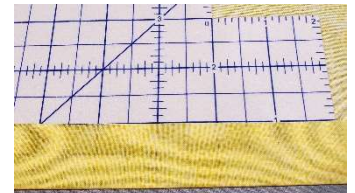


During this class we will learn how to change a design with your embroidery machine while making an accent pillow case to welcome the spring season. During this class we will explore using group/ungroup, mirror, move, and delete functions. If your embroidery machine does not have all these functions, you will still be able to construct the project as completed designs will be provided.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class. Regarding fabric, quilter's cotton works best.

Pillow Case Fabric:

- Front – 15" x 17 ½"
- Back – 13" x 17". On one of the 13" sides, fold and press 1" with wrong sides together. Fold and press another 1" (so 13" raw edge is inside the fold).
- Back – 13" x 8". With wrong sides together, fold and press in half to make a 13" x 4" piece.



Stabilizers:

- OESD Fuse and Fleece – 3 ½" x 12". Center and press to the folded 13" x 4" back piece. Fuse and Fleece should be against the fold, leaving ½" of fabric on the other three sides.
- OESD Fuse and Fleece – 13" x 17 ½". Press to the back of the 15" x 17 ½" front fabric. There should be 1" of fabric on each of the 17 ½" sides.
- OESD Ultra Clean and Tear or Medium Weight Tear Away. Bring your roll. This will be used to embroider the designs on the front.
- OESD Medium Weight Tear Away. This will be used to embroider the buttonholes on the back. This will tear away cleaner than the Ultra Clean and Tear. One piece to fit your Large Oval hoop.

Buttons – 4, ¾" size, either flat or shank style. Larger or thick buttons will not fit the buttonholes that will be embroidered.

Isacord Threads: Be creative. You can choose other thread colors from your stash.

- Pink detail – sample is 2153.
- Blue detail – sample is 3820.
- Dark green detail – sample is 5633.
- Lavender detail – sample is 3241.
- Light green detail – sample is 5832.
- Color to match your pillow fabric for buttonholes – sample is yellow.

Bobbin thread:

- Sereline for embroidery
- Color to match pillow case fabric.

Needle – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12 or, 90/14

Pillow – rectangle 12” x 16”

Embroidery machine – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

Feet - #26 (embroidery), #37/57/97 (1/4” foot), and #20 (open toe)

Hoop – Large oval

Stitch plate – Single-hole 0mm (if you have one) and regular

Other:

Scissors for thread

Rotary cutter

Ruler

Flash Drive

Tweezers

Fabric marker

Pins

Turning tool (to turn corners)
