

## Hemingway Pouch Student Supply List

### Supply Requirements

	Small 4" x 8"	Medium 7" x 8 1/2"	Large 9" x 12"	Extra Large 11" x 13"
Approximate size of flat item that will fit inside *	Up to 3" x 7" (Pencils, Eyeglasses, Rotary Cutter)	Up to 6" x 7" (E-reader / Kindle or small book)	Up to 8" x 10" (Tablet, Standard iPad, Book Sleeve)	Up to 10" x 11" (Large Tablet or iPad, Paper Notebook)
Main Fabric	Fat Quarter	Fat Quarter	Fat Quarter	2/3 yard
Lining Fabric	Fat Quarter	Fat Quarter	Fat Quarter	2/3 yard
Accent Fabric	Fat Eighth or 1/8 yard	Fat Eighth or 1/8 yard	1/4 yard	1/4 yard
Foam Stabilizer (such as Soft and Stable) or Batting	10" x 12"	16" x 13"	21" x 18"	25" x 20"
Zipper (size #4.5 or #5 recommended)	14" or longer	20" or longer	24" or longer	28" or longer

Zipper info: #4.5 or #5 zippers by the yard are perfect for this project. Be sure to select a good quality brand (Sallie Tomato, byAnnie, Wawak, or Zipper Valley, etc.); reattaching the pulls that come with the lesser-known brands can be a problem with the construction method for this pouch!

#### Basic Sewing Kit

- Thread in neutral shade to match fabric: Aurifil 50 weight works well for machine quilting the body of the pouch, but I prefer a stronger thread for the actual bag construction. Superior So Fine or Mettler polyester threads are good options.

- Strong Pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper

### **Sewing Machine, etc.**

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking foot with guide bar
- 1/4" piecing foot
- Zipper foot
- Overcast foot or a foot that will allow you to stitch a zig zag stitch
- 90/14 Topstitch needle

### **Rotary Cutting Supplies**

- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic rulers - my favorite sizes:
  - 4" x 14"
  - 6" x 24"
- Cutting mat, 18" x 24" (optional)

### **Misc Tools & Notions**

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Clover Chaco Liner (white only!) or hera marker
- Clover Tailor's Awl or stiletto
- Marking pen or pencil
- Utility scissors or designated rotary cutter for trimming zippers

### **Optional Supplies:**

- 1/8" basting tape

### **Additional Notes:**

- Please cut your fabrics prior to class using the chart on p. 3 of the pattern.
- We will have plenty of time in class to do the walking foot quilting, but you are welcome to do that ahead of time if you wish. I will have various samples of quilting designs to give you some ideas.
- Low loft batting can be used in place of the Soft and Stable.
- Plan on making more than one pouch – these are quick and easy! ☺
