

#### Miniature Quilt Series





"Mini Dutchman"



"Wild Geese" 17" x 17" or 35" x 35"

You choose which quilt you would like to make or you may decide you would like to make both. Quilts were designed by Katrina Thomas at Hope Chest Quilting. The "Mini Dutchman" pattern uses Studio 180 Design Wing Clipper to make perfect Flying Geese. The "Wild Geese" pattern uses Studio 180 Design Wing Clipper and Square Square tools to make the Flying Geese and Square in a Square.

#### **SUPPLY LIST**

- Pattern "Mini Dutchman" OR "Wild Geese" pattern by Katrina Thomas of The Hope Chest (available at the Old Country Store)
- Wing Clipper 1 OR Pint Size Wing Clipper Studio 180 Design (available at the Old Country Store) and Square Squared for Wild Geese Quilt
- Quilter's Magic Wand or another 1/4" seam guide (available at the Old Country Store)

#### **Basic Sewing and Quilting Supplies -**

- Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot, a new needle, power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread 50 wt is good for piecing
- Seam ripper
- Scissor snips
- Extra fine pins Clover Patchwork Extra Fine Pins or Magic Pins extra fine
- Small cutting mat 12" x 12" or larger

- Rotary Cutter with a new blade
- Marking pen or pencil (frixon pen or marking pencil such as Sewline)
- Invisigrip or true grips highly recommended for back of tools
- Stiletto or Purple thing to help guide small patches while stitching

# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS for "MINI DUTCHMAN" (18" x 18")

You can make it all Scrappy Blocks as shown or choose to repeat a two color block.

Light Flying Geese - Blocks	1/2 yd total
Dark Background - Blocks	5/8 yd total
Setting Triangles	1/2 yd
1st Border	1/8 yd
2nd Border	1/4 yd
Binding	1/4 yd
Backing	24"



### **FULL CUTTING DIRECTIONS for "MINI DUTCHMAN"**

The Dutchman's Puzzle Block consists of eight  $1/2" \times 1"$  Flying Geese Units. The units are made oversized and trimmed down with the Wing Clipper tool. Don't panic - lots of fun!

FABRIC	CUT
Light Flying Geese	54 - 2 1/2" total squares, 2 squares for each Block
Dark Background for Flying Geese Blocks	216 - 1 1/2" total squares, 8 squares for each Block
Setting Triangles	11 - 4 1/4" squares, cut on <b>BOTH</b> diagonals ( A Triangles ) 6 - 2 1/2" squares, cut on <b>ONE</b> diagonal ( B Triangles )
1st Border	2 - 1" strips x WOF
2nd Border	2 - 2" strips x WOF
Binding	2 strips x WOF - Width is determined by size of binding that you choose to make. I chose to make 1/8" Binding with 1 1/4" strips.

# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS for "WILD GEESE" (17" x 17" or 35" x 35")

FABRIC	17" x 17"	35" x 35"
Background	5/8 yd	1 1/8 yds
Red (or Scraps)	1/3 yd	1/2 yd
Inner Border	1/8 yd	1/4 yd
Outer Border and Binding	1/3 yd	7/8 yd
Backing	5/8 yd	1 1/4 yds



Make your quilt using two main fabrics and an accent border or dip into your scrap bin when making the flying geese.

# FULL CUTTING DIRECTIONS for "WILD GEESE" size 17" x 17" OR 35" x 35"

FABRIC	UNIT	<b>CUTTING - 17" x 17"</b>	CUTTING - 35" x 35"
Background	Square Squared	1 - 1 3/4" strip x WOF, sub-cut 18 - 1 3/4" squares, cut on <b>ONE</b> diagonal for 36 triangles	1 - 2 1/4" strip x WOF, sub-cut 18 - 2 1/4" squares, cut on <b>ONE</b> diagonal for 36 triangles
	Flying Geese	5 - 1 1/2" strips x WOF, sub-cut 144 - 1/1/2" squares, you will need remainder of above strip to get the last few squares	7 - 2" strips x WOF, sub-cut 144 - 2" squares
	Setting Triangles	1 - 4 1/4" strip x WOF, sub-cut 9 - 4 1/4" squares cut on <b>BOTH</b> diagonals for 18 triangles	2 - 7" strips x WOF, sub-cut 9 - 7" squares cut on <b>BOTH</b> diagonals for 18 triangles
	Corner Triangles	1 - 2" strips x WOF, sub-cut 18 - 2" squares, cut on <b>ONE</b> diagonal for 36 triangles	1 - 2 1/2" strip x WOF, Sub-cut 18 - 2 1/2" squares, cut on <b>ONE</b> diagonal for 36 triangles, you will need the remainder of the above strip to get the last few squares
Red	Flying Geese	3 - 2 1/2" strips x WOF, sub-cut 36 - 2 1/2" squares	3 - 3 1/2" strips x WOF, sub-cut 36 - 3 1/2" squares
	Square Squared	Cut remainder of last strip into: 1 - 1 1/4" strip	1 - 2" strip x WOF
Inner Border		2 - 1" strips x WOF	4 - 1 3/4" strips x WOF

FABRIC	UNIT	<b>CUTTING - 17" x 17"</b>	<b>CUTTING - 35" x 35"</b>
Outer Border and Binding		2 - 2" strips x WOF 2 binding strips - width is determined by size of binding you choose to make. I chose to make an 1/8" binding with 1 1/4" strips	<ul><li>4 - 4" strips x WOF</li><li>4 binding strips</li></ul>
