### Napkins

- I purchased my napkins at HomeGoods. You can make your napkins if you prefer, but when you come to class please have your napkins ready to stitch on.
  - You will have time in class to make at least 12 napkins.

### Stabilizer

- Aqua Mesh
- Aqua Mesh Plus
  - I used one layer of Aqua Mesh and one layer of Aqua Mesh Plus for each of my napkins.

### Additional Options

- Thread Stand for embroidery and sewing – Can be purchased at the Old Country Store
  - If you don't have a tread stand you can use a bowl sitting on the table behind your machine. This is a must use when sewing with metallic thread.
- Quilter's Cut n Press (optional) – Can be purchased at the Old Country Store

## Thread

- Bring a variety of threads including all the colors needed for the completion of your Napkins. Please refer to your chosen Napkin design for suggested colors. I incorporated some of the same colors used in my placemats to create cohesion between the two projects.

## Bobbin Thread:

- Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

## Bobbin Case:

- If you have a yellow bobbin case it is highly recommended that you bring this to class.

## Needles: -

- Schmetz Microtex 80/12
- Schmetz Metallic 80/12 – if using metallic thread

**Spray Adhesive:** 505 preferred

**Embroidery Machine:** – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

- **Feet:** - #26 (embroidery foot)

**Hoop:** - Medium Hoop

**Stitch plate:** Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

## Other:

Small old towel or drop cloth

Thread snips

small and large ruler

Flash drive to load projects

Straight pins

Fabric scissors

Your machine manual

Paper for taking notes

Sewing needles

Air Temporary Marker

Tweezers

paper scissors

rotary cutter

small applique scissors

seam ripper

press cloth

embroidery tape
