

Supply List for Quilter's Big Tote Class by Minki Kim

The pattern is available at The Old Country Store

Soft & Stable - 1 yard

Strapping -1.5 inches wide x 2 yards. (Polypro ByAnnie is an great choice)

Lining -1 yard

Bottom panel of bag and binding for top of bag - 1 fat quarter

20 assorted dark prints of 10 inch squares

20 assorted light prints of 10 inch squares

Thread for piecing and quilting

*Spray adhesive such as Odif 505 for use in securing your 'quilt sandwich' for quilting

OptionalFabric glue like Roxanne or Baste It or clips are used for creating the strap

For a scrappy tote --leftover charm packs or enough scraps to equal 40 - 10 inch squares. For scrappy handles as shown in pattern --18 3x5 pieces are needed.

Sewing notions highly recommended are clover clips, a stiletto, and pins

***For a solid top (unpieced) you will need (2) 21 x 16.5 pieces of fabric--check the direction of the fabric.

***For one side pieced and one side unpieced you will need 10 assorted dark and 10 assorted light prints of 10 inch squares or equivalent and one 21 x 16.5 inch piece for other side

Suggestions for unpieced fabric include cheater prints and florals

Binding or handle suggestions are fabric in gingham print and stripes

*****Please have all of your fabric, strapping, and foam completely cut out before class. This is very important to save time. Thank you!

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
