

Emerson Crossbody Bag:

Pattern: You will need to purchase the pattern: The Emerson Crossbody Bag by *The Blanket Statement*

- If you choose to purchase this pattern as a download, it is very important that you print the pattern at 100% scale. Otherwise, the pieces will not be the correct size.

Fabric and Interfacing as per recommended in the pattern:

- Exterior fabric per the pattern requirements
 - Note, this pattern works best with non-directional fabric. If you use directional fabric, you may need more than the pattern calls for.
- Lining Fabric per the pattern requirements
- Coordinating Polyester Thread
 - There is topstitching on the webbing as well as the exterior and interior of the bag. You may want more than one color of coordinating thread for this project.
- Batting or Fusible Fleece
- Small piece of Fusible Woven Interfacing (Pellon SF101) for the Belt Wings
- 2 yards - Bias Binding OR an extra 15" x 15" piece to make your own bias binding.

Hardware as per recommended in the pattern:

- Zippers per recommended in the pattern.
 - Use zipper that have wide zipper tape. #3 YKK zippers are too narrow for this pattern. You will need zippers with teeth that are labeled as #4.5 or #5.
 - I like to use a Nylon Zipper By the Yard to create your own length of zipper tape (which I can show you in class how to do). I recommend Sallie Tomato Brand #5 size.
- 1" Webbing as recommended in the pattern OR you can use an additional ¼ yd of fabric to create your own strap.
- 1" Side Release Buckle and 1" Tri Glide Slide Adjuster OR You can use a Level 3 Basic 1" Hardware kit from Sallie Tomato (which includes 2 D-Rings, 2 Swivel Hooks and 1 Slider Buckle)

Tools and Notions:

- Rotary cutter
- Long Ruler (I like to use 6 x 24)
- Small square ruler (I like to use 4.5" square)
- Pins
- Safety pins for basting or Basting Spray (whichever is your preferred method)
- Clips
- Seam Ripper
- Fabric scissors
- A small pair of sharp scissors with a point
- Elmers School Glue or Fabric glue
- Stiletto Tool
- Dritz Fray Check if using a nylon webbing
- Tailors Chalk (if using dark fabrics)
- Disappearing ink pen for marking on fabric

Sewing Machine:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Regular sewing foot attachment for the sewing machine
- Zipper foot attachment for the sewing machine
- Walking foot for quilting the fabric
- Size 90/14 sewing machine needles

Before Class:

Please have all your materials ready and your paper pattern pieces from the Emerson Crossbody Bag Pattern precut and assembled before the class begins. We will begin the class by quilting the fabrics together.
