

Potato Chip Block Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order. A straight stitch is the only kind required for this project. All of the blocks in the sample were pieced on Singer Featherweights.
- A jelly roll or scraps in a variety of light, medium, and dark values. One jelly roll will make about fifteen 12 ½" blocks. If you precut your fabric into pieces that are 2 ½" by 4 ½" inches you will be able to make multiple blocks during the class. Each block is made up of 18 pieces.
- Thread in a neutral color.
- Rotary cutter and mat. Cutting mats are available in the Classroom.
- 12 ½" ruler for squaring up blocks.
- Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, etc.
- Optional: ¼" presser foot, iron and ironing mat, pressing bar.
