

## Supply List

Background- 8x10 Felted Wool (This can be a solid or a texture)

Pumpkin- 6x8 Felted Wool (This can be a solid , but a textured wool looks great)

Leaves, Stem- (4) 4” Squares of Felted Wool. (Old Country store has charm packs that would work for this)

Star- 3” Square of black Felted Wool (optional)

Freezer paper- A piece at least 10” by 12”

Embroidery/Chenille Needle- Size 24 or 22

Thread- Valdani or Dmc pearl cotton size 8 or 12 (I use size 12 ) Also 2 strands of Dmc embroidery thread can be used. Colors can match your wool or contrast. I usually choose a variegated thread of green or brown to use on all the leaves/stem. The Old Country Store carries Valdani size 8.

Pencil or fine tip Sharpie- For tracing your shapes

Marking pencil – white or grey (I use Bohin mechanical pencil) This is used to mark the veins on the leaves , vines , and lettering for embroidery.

Small scissors- I use a serrated scissors.

Small pins

- Felted Wool is wool that has been washed or soaked in hot water and dried on hot setting. If your wool is hand dyed it is already felted. When purchasing wool directly off a bolt, it will need to be felted.
