

Embroidered Book/I-Pad Sleeve



Supply list:

Sizes of the Book or I-pad sleeve

- You will have choices on what you make:
- There are 4 sizes, but if you need a bigger size, we can develop the measurements the day of the class
- Small – 8 ½ x 6 ½
- Medium – 7 ½ x 10 ½
- Large – 9 ½ x 11 ½
- Extra Large 11 ½ x 13 ½

Embroidery pattern

- For this class you will be selecting your own embroidery pattern customizing it to suit your personally or to personalize a gift for a loved one.
- Please be mindful of the size
- It should be, at least, half the size of your front sleeve.
- Example: If making the large sleeve your design should not be more than 4 ¾ inches in width and no more than 5 ¾ in length

Fabric and notions

All fabric will be cut out during class time.

All sizes will need the snaps, pliers, and hair tie

- (1) plastic snap at 1/2 inch (you will be using 4 pieces)
- (1) plastic snap pliers
- (1) skinny hair tie
- **Small Book/I-Pad sleeve**
- (1) piece of exterior and (2) lining fabrics cut at 6 ½ x 8 ½
- (1) exterior at 10 x 11
- (1) pocket cut at 6 ½ x 12
- **Medium size Book/I-Pad sleeve**
- (1) piece of exterior and (2) lining fabrics cut at 7 ½ x 10 ½
- (1) exterior at 11 x 12
- (1) pocket cut at 7 ½ x 14
- **Large size Book/I-Pad sleeve**
- (1) piece of exterior and (2) lining fabrics cut at 9 ½ x 11 ½
- (1) exterior at 12 x 13
- (1) pocket cut at 9 ½ x 17
- **Extra Large Size Book/I-Pad sleeve**
- (1) piece of exterior and (2) lining fabrics cut at 11 ½ x 13 ½
- (1) exterior at 13 x 14
- (1) pocket cut at 11 ½ x 22



Stabilizer

- Medium tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Fuse and Fleece – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Light tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll

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Thread

- Bring a variety of threads that you plan on using for your design. Look at the color chart that goes with the design chosen. Have fun mixing and matching different colors to make it your own.

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

Needles: - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. *I recommend the Microtex 90/14.*

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot) #97, #97C, or #97D

Hoop: - medium or large oval hoop

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

Other:

Small old towel or drop cloth

Temporary Marker or pencil

Thread snips

Tweezers

small and large ruler

Straight pins

Fabric scissors

seam ripper

Your machine manual

Press cloth

Paper for taking notes

rotary cutter

There is no pattern. I will be explaining how to put your sleeve together in a step-by-step sequence.
