## BERNINA Embroidery Club – November 2024 Gift Card Holder Supply List



During this class we will embroider on cork or Luxe Sparkle Vinyl while making a gift card holder. Cork and Luxe Sparkle Vinyl is very durable and a change from the usual cotton fabric.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class. If you choose to use fabric for the lining, quilter's cotton will work best. The supplies are for one gift card holder. Bring extra as there will be time to construct more than one.

**Outside:** (where design is embroidered)

• 1 − 3 3/8" x 4 7/8", either cork or Luxe Sparkle Vinyl. Sample is cork.


Lining: (sample is Luxe Sparkle Vinyl)

• 1 − 3 3/8" x 4 7/8", your choice of cork, Luxe Sparkle Vinyl, or quilter's cotton. If you choose quilter's cotton, you should adhere fusible interfacing BEFORE cutting to size (e.g., fusible woven, P44F, or whatever you have). Adhering interfacing will minimize fraying.

Sleeve: (sample is cork)

• 1 – 3 3/8" x 3 1/8", your choice of cork or Luxe Sparkle Vinyl. Cut out a half circle centered on a 3 3/8" side. The half circle should be about 1 1/8" across and 1/2" deep. You can use the handle of a 45 mm rotary cutter to trace and then cut out.





## Stabilizer:

1 − 10" x 14" OESD Medium Weight Tear Away

## Threads:

- Isacord Depends on your design choice.
  - "Joy" uses at least four colors. Yellow inside letters, black for outlines, green for leaves, and red for berries and heart. Triple stitch around the edge can be one of these colors or an additional color of thread. You may want to coordinate your triple stitch thread with your lining.
  - "Words" uses two colors. One for the words and a second for the triple stitch around the edge. You may want to coordinate your triple stitch thread with your lining.
- Seralene or Bottom-Line bobbin thread <u>and you want a bobbin with the same</u> thread in the bobbin as in the needle for the triple stitch seam.

**Needle** – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12

**Spray Adhesive** 505 – if you prefer. You can also do the project without using spray adhesive.

**Embroidery machine** – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc.

Feet - #26 (embroidery)

**Hoop** – Large Oval or Midi, your choice.

**Stitch plate** – single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

## Other:

Ruler

Rotary cutter

Cutting mat, small (or you can use those in the classroom)

Scissors to snip threads

Scissors to cut cork

Painter's tape or OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway
