Autumn Leaves Pattern Class 2024

*Wall Hanging - 12 blocks class sample (not the same as the wall hanging in pattern)

1 5/8 yards of background fabric

8 fat quarters in various autumn shades that will compliment each other--2 blocks can be made using 2 fat quarters--extra geese can be made from leftover FQ

1 fat quarter of green for stems- 12 stems are needed

1/4 quarter yd of fusible web

Batting 43 x 48 minimal piece

Extra--Scraps of at least 7 inches square if scrappy look is desired

1/3 of a yard for binding

2.5 yards for backing

*Yardage for Four Leaves

This will make a 3 or 4 Leaf Table Runner Top

1/2 yard background

Leaf 1 Top 1 fat quarter

Leaf 2 Middle 1 fat quarter

Leaf 3 Bottom 1 fat quarter

Green leaf stem 1/8 or scrap of 7 inches to accommodate 4 stems-refer to pattern template

Additional yardage to complete Table Runner Top

1/4 yard Background

1/2 yard Border

3/8 yard Binding

Backing

3 Leaf Table Runner 1 1/2 yards

4 Leaf Table Runner 1 2/3 yards

Batting

3 Leaf 32 x 48

4 Leaf 32 x 58

Rulers

Eleanor Burns Mini Geese Ruler One for finished 2 x 4 inch Geese

4.5 inch On Point Ruler (included with Autumn Leaves Pattern)

*optional for scrappy quilt-- small piece of plastic 5.5 inches square to make a template of a portion of a leaf tip

*Tru Grip dots are recommended for the rulers

Optional: Non slip Quilter's Select Rulers-- I used: 4.5, 6 x 12, 1.5 x 12. I consistently use a 6 x 24, 2.5 x 2.5 and a 6 x 6.

*A small rotating cutting board is extremely helpful and recommended with this pattern.

Sewing supplies: Thread, pins, clips, rotary cutter, seam ripper, scissors, pencil or chalk for drawing lines. If you prefer, your own travel iron and mat.
