- Please bring a logo of your choice (whether it's text, an image, or a combination of both) on a flash drive to use in this project. If you have the Bernina Software package, this is a great opportunity to combine designs, but having the software is not required to complete the project. However, you will need to have your design ready on a flash drive for the day of class. If you're unsure how to load your machine with a purchased design or how to transfer a design to your flash drive, feel free to reach out to Beth at eamplanner@comcast.net for assistance.

Apron

- You do not need to bring any fabric, just a premade apron. Advanced students may consider bringing an extra apron to work on once they've finished their first.
 - Please prewash and iron your apron before bringing to class.
- If you have an embroidery software program, please print your designs. If you don't, that's okay we will go over how to center your design without the printed design.

Stabilizer

- Medium tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Light tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Fusible Woven stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Gentle Touch Backing – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.

Thread

- Bring a variety of threads including all the colors needed for the front of your sweatshirt and sleeve.

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

Needles: - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. *I recommend the Microtex 90/14.*

Embroidery Machine: – bring all items to make your machine work 😊

Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot)

Hoop: - Medium hoop, large hoop or midi hoop (Depending on the size of your apron and design. I used a large hoop for my design)

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

Other:

Temporary Marker or pencil (I prefer a sewline air marker)

Thread snips

small and large ruler

Flash drive to load projects

Straight pins

Tweezers

paper scissors

rotary cutter

Small thread scissors

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Fabric scissors

Your machine manual

Paper for taking notes

seam ripper
