## **Embroidered Custom Towel**

Supply list:

To be purchased online or located in your Embroidery machine.

- Custom Class Details
  - Please bring a logo of your choice on a flash drive to use in this project. We will be using the fonts inside your machine to write something special if you like. You will need to have your design ready on a flash drive for the day of class. If you're unsure how to load your machine with a purchased design or how to transfer a design to your flash drive, feel free to reach out to Beth at eaplaner@comcast.net for assistance.
  - When choosing your design, you will want to find one that is very loose looking. No heavy designs. A heavy design would not "feel" nice on this type of project. The flowers on my design are 4 inches long by 3 inches wide. My letters are ½ inches. Please do not go any bigger than that as it will be too much for the project.

    - Use one from your machine. There are great designs on your machine.

# Also, please bring your color change sheet from your selected design site to use for guidance with your color choice and assembly.

Apron

- You do not need to bring a premade kitchen towel. You will have two towels made from one kitchen towel.
  - Please prewash and iron your towel before bringing to class.
- You will need about a 10" x 10" square for the topping of your towel.
- You will need snaps for your topping or if you prefer you can use Velcro.
   I have the pliers if you would like to use mine otherwise you will need to have size 20 pilers.
- If you have an embroidery software program, please print your designs. If you don't, that's okay we will go over how to center your design without the printed design.

#### Stabilizer

- Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll.
- Stitch H20 Stabilizer I used OESD I recommend bringing your roll.
- 911FF Fusible Featherweight Stabilizer 6" x 6" for each towel

#### Thread

- Bring a variety of embroidery threads including all the colors needed for the front of your sweatshirt and sleeve.
- Can use your embroidery thread to sew your topping together, but if you prefer you can also use regular thread for sewing. I used Aurifil for mine. You will need to have this thread in the bobbin also. Please have it prewound.

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound
Needles: - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. *I recommend the Microtex 90/14.*Embroidery Machine: – bring all items to make your machine work <sup>☺</sup>
Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot)





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Hoop: - Medium hoop, large hoop (Depending on the size of your apron and design. I used a large hoop for my design) Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm Other: Temporary Marker or pencil (I prefer a sewline air marker) Thread snips Tweezers small and large ruler paper scissors Flash drive to load projects rotary cutter Straight pins Small thread scissors Fabric scissors seam ripper Your machine manual Press cloth Paper for taking notes 505 spray if desired
