

BERNINA Embroidery Club – January 2025 Paper Pieced Mug Rug Supply List



During this class we will create a mug rug in the hoop using paper piecing techniques. We will add word(s) to work on placement and design editing.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class.

Fabric: (quilter's cotton works best)

- Cup – 1, 6" x 6" (sample is lavender)
- Background – 1, 6" x 10" (sample is black with colored dots)
- Side – 1, 3" x 5" (sample is black with gray dots)
- Backing – 1, 5 ½" x 16 ½" (sample is black with colored dots)

Stabilizer:

- OESD Poly Mesh Fusible – 1, piece to fit your hoop (large oval or midi)

Batting:

- Cotton batting – 1, 5 ½" x 8" (e.g., Quilter's Dream or Warm & Natural)

Fusible Interfacing: (double sided, e.g., Heat n Bond Lite, Wonder Under, or OESD Applique Fuse and Fix)

- 1 – 5 ½" x 2 ¾"
- 1 – 5 ½" x 5 ½"
- 1 – 4" x 1 ½"

Threads:

- Isacord
 - Color that matches your fabrics to sew the pieces together
 - Color to quilt (sample is white or light gray)
 - Color for word(s) on the side (sample is blue)
- Seralene or Bottom-Line bobbin thread for the bobbin

Needle – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12

Embroidery machine – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc. If using a classroom machine, you need to bring everything other than the machine, module, bobbin case, foot control, and cord.

Feet - #26 (embroidery) and 20 (open toe) or ¼” foot

Hoop – Large Oval or Midi, your choice.

Stitch plate – single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

Other:

Ruler

Rotary cutter

Cutting mat, small (or you can use those in the classroom)

Scissors to snip threads

Scissors to cut paper

Painter’s tape or OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway

Stiletto

Turning tool

Pen

Fabric marker than can be seen on all your fabrics
