

Make both of these small throw size quilts at the same time with one layer cake + background fabric!

^{**}No background needed for mix and match version

*Note:

- 1) If cutting from stash, I prefer to cut my "layer cake" blocks 9" x at least 10 %". Then, you can simply sub cut your strips all going the same direction. The 9" length (instead of 8 %" as the pattern instructs) will also allow you to easily square up your blocks to 8 %".
- 2) If you plan to do the Inside Out version which yields two quilts in the reverse of each other, I recommend purchasing an additional $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of your background fabric. Then, simply cut 9" WOF strips, and then sub cut the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Again, this will allow you to easily square your blocks to 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". If you have a Stripology ruler, it makes cutting the sub cuts quick and easy.

Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric Shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- 8 ½" or larger square ruler
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic ruler at least 12" long
- Cutting mat for your workstation

Optional Supplies:

- Wooly Felted Wonders Pressing Bar and Clapper (the 12" size is sufficient), or The Strip Stick in case you wish to press your seams open.
- Rotating cutting mat big enough for an 8 1/2" square ruler

Sewing Machine, etc.:

- Sewing machine in working order
- ¼" patchwork foot, if you have
- Sewing machine needles, size 80/12 sharp or universal
