BERNINA Embroidery Club – March 2025 Lemon Table Topper Supply List



During this class we will construct a table topper with embroidered lemons to help us think ahead to spending time on the porch drinking lemonade when the gets warmer. The project will focus on design placement, a skill that is important to machine embroidery. Making bias tape for the binding will also allow attaching the binding to curves without having creases.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class.

Fabric: (quilter's cotton works best)

- Top and back $-\frac{1}{2}$ yard fabric or 2 fat quarters (sample is black)
- Binding $\frac{1}{4}$ yard fabric (sample is green). You can bind however you want. Given the curves, the sample was made by creating bias tape from 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide fabric.

Stabilizer:

- OESD Fuse and Fleece enough to cover a 17" diameter circle. Bring your roll and any scrap pieces you want to use up. This can be pieced.
- OESD Medium Weight Tear Away bring your roll. How much you need depends on what hoop you're using.

Batting – 1, 18" x 18" piece of low loft batting. If you don't have any, check with The Old Country Store. They usually have remnants for sale.

Threads:

- Isacord for embroidery. Thread colors listed are what is in the sample. You may substitute from your stash.
 - o 0010 Silky White
 - o 0310 Yellow
 - 0311 Canary
 - o 0520 Daffodil

- o 5510 Emerald
- o 5610 Bright Mint
- o 5740 Mint
- Isacord or Mettler to match binding
- Isacord or Mettler to match top/back
- Bobbin Seralene or Bottom-Line bobbin thread for embroidery
- Bobbin Isacord or Mettler, same as used to sew binding on
- Bobbin Isacord or Mettler, same as used to match top/back

Needle – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12

Embroidery machine – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc. If using a classroom machine, you need to bring everything other than the machine, module, bobbin case, foot control, and cord.

Feet - #26 (embroidery) and 20 (open toe) and 1/4" foot

Hoop – If your machine has Pin Point Placement, Midi or Large Oval. If your machine does not have Pin Point Placement, Midi or Large Oval <u>and</u> Medium.

Stitch plate – 9mm and single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

Other:

Ruler

Rotary cutter

Scissors to snip threads

Wonder clips

Straight Pins

Stiletto

Fabric marker than can be seen on your top/back fabric
