

**BERNINA** Embroidery Club – April 2025  
Edge-to-Edge Quilted Table Runner Supply List



In this class we will quilt a table runner with an edge-to-edge design, learning placement and the possibilities of changing the quilted pattern by using the mirroring functions. Quilting will be done using two shades of thread to add a color pop to the quilting stitches.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class, completing any prerequisite work. **Choose which hoop you're using (Midi or Large Oval), then prepare fabric and stabilizer accordingly as shown below.** You can make the smaller runner in the Midi hoop but you can't make the larger runner in the Large Oval hoop.

**If using Midi hoop** – finished size is 9 ½" x 33"

**Fabric:** (quilter's cotton works best)

- Center panel – 1, 11" x 44" (WOF) (sample is white)
- Backing – 1, 15 ½" x 39" (sample is green)

**Stabilizer:**

- OESD Fusible Woven – 1, 11" x 44". Fuse to back of center panel. Make sure it is thoroughly fused.
- OESD Fuse and Fleece – 1, 11" x 44". Fuse to back of Fusible Woven after Fusible Woven is fused to center panel. Make sure it is thoroughly fused.

**If using Large Oval hoop** – finished size is 8 ½” x 30 ½”

**Fabric:** (quilter’s cotton works best)

- Center panel – 1, 10” x 44” (WOF) (sample is white)
- Backing – 1, 14 ½” x 36 ½” (sample is green)

**Stabilizer:**

- OESD Fusible Woven – 1, 10” x 44”. Fuse to back of center panel. Make sure it is thoroughly fused.
- OESD Fuse and Fleece – 1, 10” x 44”. Fuse to back of Fusible Woven after Fusible Woven is fused to center panel. Make sure it is thoroughly fused.

**Threads:**

- Two shades that are close in color for quilting. Sample used 2510 and 2723.
- White or cream to stitch back to center panel. You will not see this, but at least your quilting colors won’t “shine” through.

**Bobbin Threads:**

- Same as one of your quilting threads.
- Color that will be seen on back if you don’t want to use the quilting color. This will be used to stitch around the border.

**Needle** – Embroidery or Microtex 80/12

**Embroidery machine** – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc. **If using a classroom machine, you need to bring everything other than the machine, module, bobbin case, foot control, and cord.**

**Feet** - #26 (embroidery) and #1 or #20 (open toe) and whatever foot you like to stitch about 1/8” from edge.

**Hoop** – Midi or Large Oval. Bring grid along too.

**Stitch plate** – 9mm and single-hole 0mm (if you have one)

**Seam Guide** – white piece that clips on your slide-on table to guide when stitching larger seams. This came with your machine.

**Other:**

- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- Scissors to snip threads
- Wonder clips and/or Straight pins
- Stiletto
- Fabric marker than can be seen on your top/back fabric
