

## April Supply List:



**Please have all fabric cut and preped for Class.**

- Sewing machine and all gadgets that you need to use your machine 😊
- Open Embroidery Foot #20/20C/20D (choose one)
- Zipper Foot #4/4D
- Open Embroidery Foot #6, Open Embroidery Foot #23 Clear Embroidery Foot #39/39C (Choose one)
- Kitchen Hand Towel – We will be stitching a decorative design on this hand towel
  - Light or medium OESD stabilizer – I recommend bringing your roll
  - Ultra Clean and Tear stabilizer – I recommend you bring your roll
  - StitchH2O OESD stabilizer – I recommend bringing your roll
  - Scissors for cutting on paper
- Hot Piping – see note and supply list below
- Microtex needles
- Bobbin with the same thread color as your decorative thread

Variety thread colors – I recommend Isacord or Mettler

Seam ripper

Note: Please prepare items below before class.

- Have a 12 x 12 inch quilt sandwich prepared with light quilting. Do not trim. Batting and backing will show when coming to class.
- Have a piece of binding cut at 155 inches by 2 ½ inches.
- Have another piece of binding cut at 155 inches by 1 ¼ inches.
  - Have both pieces of bindings ironed in half.
- Piping Hot Binding Cording 1mm x 100yds Reel – picture to the right
