

Improv Scrap Play Supply List

Fabric:

- Fabric scraps, sorted into two or three color groups that you love and believe work well together. In addition to small scraps, bring several larger chunks in the same color groups.
- Orphan blocks or parts of blocks from previous projects that fall into the same color groups as the scraps you bring. These are optional.

Notions:

- Scrap Tape (2.5" width)
- One quarter yard each of interfacing: Pellon 50 and 70--sew-in type.
- Batting scraps
- Glue stick
- Two kinds of thread: neutral thread for strip assembly and coordinating thread colors for decorative topstitching--metallic, variegated, solids—any colors that will go well with the scraps you have brought along.
- Wooden pressing tool or seam roller. Finger pressing will do, but one of these will make the process easier and better.
- Rotary cutter
- Quilt ruler--at least 18"

Sewing Machine, etc.:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Walking Foot for your machine.
- 2 Sewing machine needles: universal size 90/14 will work nicely. You will use one for the strip construction and another for the card fabrication. Once you have used a needle to sew through paper or card stock, it is wise to dedicate it to that purpose for future projects.
- Fabric Scissors and thread snips
- Seam Ripper
