

Digitized/Embroidered Bookmarks

Class Prerequisites:

- Software Experience: Completion of the Mary Alice free software class or equivalent experience with Bernina software.
- Machine Proficiency: A working knowledge of your embroidery machine, gained through instructors Embroidery Machine class, Wonda's Embroidery Club classes, or hands-on experience.

Supplies for In-Class Digitizing:

- A computer with Bernina software installed and ready to use.

Supplies for Digitized Stitch-Out:

- **Fabric:**
I recommend using your fabric scraps. All fabric will be prepared during class, so please bring at least one or two fat quarters to provide options for your bookmark designs.

Stabilizer

- Heavy Cut away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
 - You will want enough to hoop 2 designs using a large hoop.
- P44F Fusible Interfacing
 - You will need at least the size of a fat quarter

Thread

- Please bring a curated selection of embroidery threads that includes at least one representative shade from each color family (warm, cool, and neutral). There's no need for an extensive assortment—just a few versatile hues to work with.
- Please bring a small assortment of sewing threads that complement your fabric for a polished finished bookmark. (You will need a bobbin for this thread. Please have it prewound)

Bobbin Thread: - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

Needles: - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 90/14. *I recommend the Microtex 90/14.*

Spray Adhesive: 505 preferred

Embroidery Machine: – bring your machine, module, cords foot control, etc.

Feet: - #26 (embroidery foot) 97, 97C, or 97D

Hoop: - large hoop or midi hoop

Stitch plate: Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

Other:

Temporary Marker or pencil

Thread snips

small and large ruler

Flash drive to load projects

Straight pins

Fabric scissors

Your machine manual

Paper for taking notes

Tweezers

paper scissors

rotary cutter

point turner

seam ripper
