

## **BERNINA** Embroidery Club – June 2025 T-shirt Butterfly Embroidery Supply List



In this class we will embroider an applique on a t-shirt. We will combine two designs and then place them on the t-shirt. Embroidery skills we will use are Mirror, Rotate, Move, and working with multiple layers in the design. Proper stabilization on both top and under the design will be discussed. Attendees should be able to select and embroider something else on their own with the concepts covered in this class.

Please review this supply list and bring the requested items to class, completing any prerequisite work.

### **T-shirt:**

- 1 clean, new or used t-shirt

### **Fabric for Butterfly:**

- 1, 2" x 2 ½" piece of quilter's cotton

### **Stabilizer:**

- 2 layers of OESD Poly Mesh for the Medium hoop.
- 1 layer of OESD Stitch20 for the Medium hoop.
- 1, 2" x 2 ½" OESD Applique Fuse and Fix – I will provide this in class if you don't have it.

### **Threads** (Isacord for the following):

- Leaf/vine work.
- Stipple stitching on wings
- Antennae and body

### **Bobbin Thread** – Seraline

### **Needle** – Jersey or Ballpoint.

**Feet** - #26 (embroidery)

**Hoop** – Medium

**Stitch plate** –single-hole 0mm (if you have one), otherwise 9mm.

**Embroidery machine** – bring your machine, module, cords, foot control, etc. **If using a classroom machine, you need to bring everything other than the machine, module, bobbin case, foot control, and cord.**

**Other:**

Rotary cutter

Scissors to snip threads and cut fabric

Scissors to cut paper

Wonder clips and Straight pins

Stiletto
