

# Custom Appliqued/Embroidered Reading Pillow

## Digitize Design

### ▪ Custom Class Details

- I have digitized the design that you will use on your reading pillow. Please reference the picture to see the design that will be provided to you the morning of our class
  - FYI – I used the same idea of the digitized design from ShabbyFabrics. However, I made my own digitized work so we could make the pillow look similar to the original.

## Fabric

- ½ yard or 1 ¼ yard for pillow and handle
  - If you have fabric with a parallel design you will need ½ yard of fabric
  - If you have fabric that has a perpendicular design you will need 1 ¼ yards of fabric. But, you will have enough fabric to make 2 reading pillows
- ½ yard for pocket
- Scraps of green, brown and another color for the word “READ.”
- Batting – at least 20x20 inches square
- 1 1/3 yard of Fusible Interfacing – I used Pellon P44F Fusible Interfacing

## Stabilizer

- Medium tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.
- Light tear away stabilizer – I used OESD – I recommend bringing your roll.

## Thread

- Bring a variety of threads that match the colors of your desired applique and fabric.
- Have a bobbin prewound with the colors needed for sewing around your pillow.

**Bobbin Thread:** - Seraline – please have bobbin thread prewound

**Needles:** - Embroidery 80/12 or Microtex 80/14. *I recommend the Microtex 80/14.*

**Embroidery Machine:** – bring all items to make your machine work 😊

**Feet:** - #26 (embroidery foot) , #97 (Patchwork Foot), #1 (Reverse Pattern Foot), #50 (Walking Foot)

## Pillow

- 16 x 16 inch filler pillow

**Hoop:** - large hoop

**Stitch plate:** Single hole 0mm (if you have it) or regular 9mm

**Pattern:** Please print out and bring to class
