

## Great Granny Squared Student Supply List

### Pattern:

*Great Granny Squared* booklet by Lori Holt of Bee in My Bonnet

### Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

### Additional Supplies:

- 12-1/2" square ruler (Lori Holt's Cute Cuts 12-1/2" Trim-It Ruler is perfect for this project and worth every penny. I'll demonstrate the advantages of it in class if you want to wait to purchase it.)
- 15" mini design board will be helpful for laying out your squares. Here's Lori Holt's tutorial on how to make them: <https://youtu.be/uO-fosn6Yfs?si=GuoCosnGTjUNm-JD>
- Spray starch or your favorite starch alternative

### Optional Supplies:

- Pressing station (iron and pressing board)

### Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers: I like the following sizes:
  - 6" x 22"
  - 4" x 14"
- Cutting mat: 18" x 24" is a good size

### Sewing Machine, etc:

- Sewing machine in working order
- 1/4" patchwork foot
- Sewing machine needles

**Fabric Requirements:** see pattern booklet. There are lots of project options! 😊

You may wish to cut squares for a few blocks ahead of time, or you can wait to cut your fabrics in class. No need to cut fabrics for the entire project – just enough for a block or two.
